ORDER:

In the G.O. (D) No.6, Welfare of the Differently Abled Persons (DAP-2) Department, dated 20.02.2021 orders were issued for the establishment of Halfway Homes for persons with Mental Illness, who have been improved, cured, homeless and long staying in rehabilitation homes in 5 districts namely, Madurai, Ramanathapuram, Tiruchirappalli, Kanniyakumari and Vellore.

2. The Director for the Welfare of Differently Abled has requested order for the scheme continuance for the improved mentally ill persons who are homeless, abandoned by family and long staying in rehabilitation homes are being shifted to Halfway Homes from 01.01.2022. (The amount required for running the 5 Halfway homes for 3 moths (01.01.2022 – 31.03.2022 is Rs.34,94,000/- (Rupees thirty four lakhs ninety four thousand only). In order to provide social support, safe accommodation, medical follow up, vocational training, social skill training, self employment and finally transition to independent community living, he has requested for continuance of the scheme of halfway homes rehabilitating the persons with mental illness. The amount required for running the 5 halfway homes for improved mentally ill persons for 3 months (01.01.2022 to 31.03.2022) is Rs.34,94,000/- as detailed below:-

The cost required to running for 5 Halfway Homes = $5 \times Rs.6,98,800/- = Rs.34,94,000/-$ [Feeding Charges revised from Rs.600/- to Rs.900/- vide G.O. (Ms) No.38, Welfare of the Differently Abled Persons (DAP-1) Department, dated 25.10.2018].

- 3. He has requested the Government to issue suitable orders and scheme continuance for this financial year 2021-2022 and he has also requested to permit the Director for the Welfare of the Differently Abled to incur a sum of Rs.34,94,000/- (Rupees thirty four lakhs ninety four thousand only).
- 4. The Government, after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Director for Welfare of Differently Abled and permit him to incur a sum of Rs.34,94,000/- (Rupees Thirty Four Lakhs and Ninety Four thousand only) as mentioned in the annexure to this order, to the Director, Institute of Mental Health, Chennai through the Director for Welfare of Differently Abled for establishment of Halfway Homes for Persons with Mental illness in 5 Districts namely Madurai, Ramanathapuram, Tiruchirappalli, Kanniyakumari and Vellore through reputed Non Governmental Organisations.

5. The expenditure sanctioned at para 4 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-
