ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued to delegate powers to the Principal Secretary / State Commissioner for the Differently Abled to implement the following 4 Welfare Schemes of Differently Abled Persons with the condition that the expenditure should be incurred only within the Budget provision of the respective Head of Account:-

- i. Maintenance Allowance to Mentally Retarded persons;
- ii. Maintenance Allowance to Severely Affected persons;
- iii. Maintenance Allowance to persons affected with Muscular Dystrophy; and
- iv. Maintenance Allowance to Leprosy affected persons.

Further, the Government have permitted the Principal Secretary / State Commissioner for the Differently Abled to send necessary proposal to Government for sanction of funds if required for the additional beneficiaries identified subsequently in the month of September and February.

2. In the Government Order second read above, orders were issued accord sanction for a sum of Rs.64,44,000/- to provide maintenance allowance to 1074 additional beneficiaries identified in the category of Severely affected persons during September 2015 at the rate of Rs.1500/- per month for 4 months from December 2015 to March 2016.

3. In the Government Order third read above, orders were issued accord sanction for a sum of Rs.14,84,64,000/- (8,248 x Rs.1500/- x 12 months) to provide maintenance allowance to 8,248 additional beneficiaries identified in the category of 7,174 Mentally Retarded persons and 1,074 Severely affected persons during September 2015 at the rate of Rs.1500/- per month from April 2016 to March 2017.

4. In the Government Order fourth read above, orders were issued accord sanction for a sum of Rs.52,56,000/- to provide maintenance allowance to 876 additional beneficiaries identified in the category of Severely Affected Persons during September 2016 at the rate of Rs.1500/- per month for 4 months from December 2016 to March 2017.

5. In the letter fifth read above, the State Commissioner for the Differently Abled has requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.31,20,000/- for providing maintenance allowance to 1040 beneficiaries in the category of Severely Affected Persons in waiting list of February 2017 and March 2017.

6. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of State Commissioner for the Differently Abled accord sanction for a sum of Rs.31,20,000/- (Rupees Thirty one lakhs and twenty thousand only) to provide maintenance allowance to 1040 beneficiaries identified in the category of Severely Affected Persons during the month of February 2017 and March 2017 at the rate of Rs.1500/- per month..

7. The expenditure sanctioned at para 5 above shall be debited under the following Head of Account:-

“2235- Social Security and Welfare-02. Social Welfare-101- Welfare of Differently Abled Persons- I- State’s Expenditure- CD- Maintenance Allowance to the Severely affected Differently Abled Persons-09 Grants-in-Aid-03 Grants for Specific Schemes.”
