From the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai Letter No. S7(5)/ 22610/ DRIP/ OTVI/2007, dated 22.4.2022.

#### **ORDER:**

In the letter read above, the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai has stated that based on the success of DRIP - I, DRIP Phase II and Phase III is being implemented with the budget outlay of Rs 10,211 Crore (Phase II: Rs. 5107 Crore, Phase III: Rs.5104 Crore) with the funding assistance of World Bank and Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) in the funding pattern 35:35:30 (WB : AIIB:State). Each Phase has external assistance of US \$ 500 M. The scheme duration is 10 years and each phase is of six year duration with two years overlapping. Tamil Nadu is one among the 10 States (Gujarat, Kerala, Mathya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Meghalaya, Rajasthan, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Chhattisgarh) participating in the Project. The project cost of State of Tamil Nadu under DRIP Phase II is US\$ 148.63 M (TNWRD: Rs.610.26 Crore and TANGEDCO: Rs.454 Crore). The Loan agreement and Project agreements were signed with World Bank on 04.08.2021. The loan has been declared effective since October 12, 2021. The Loan negotiation with AIIB was held on 17.02.2022. As per the conditions stipulated in schedule-2 in the loan agreement with World Bank (Loan No.9181-IN) the National Level Steering Committee (NLSC) and State Level Steering Committee (SLSC) are to be constituted and maintained throughout the Project implementation period to provide oversight on dam safety assurance and rehabilitation, as well as disaster management in the National Level as well as at the Project Implementation entity level.

2. Accordingly, Ministry of Jal Shakti has constituted National Level Steering Committee for DRIP Phase II & II with the following Terms of Reference and composition:-
