Tamil Nadu Water Resources Department – Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY), Har Khet Ko Pani (HKKP) - Phase VIII- Repair, Renovation and Restoration (RRR) of 100 water bodies at a cost of Rs.9282.98 lakhs – Approval for Declaring water bodies are free from any kind of encroachment Accorded – Orders - Issued

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, administrative Sanction has been accorded to take up 100 water bodies at an outlay of Rs.83,77,04,000/- under Phase-VIII of Repair, Renovation and Restoration Scheme under Har Khet Ko Pani component of PMKSY.

- 2. In the Government Order second read above, Revised Administrative Sanction has been accorded for a sum of Rs.9282.98 lakh including additional amount of Rs.9,05,94,000/- as additional State share under State Fund against original Administrative Sanction of Rs.8377.04 lakh to take up 100 Water Bodies under Phase VIII of Repair, Renovation and Restoration (RRR) Scheme under Har Khet Ko Pani (HKKP) component of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY).
- In the letter third read above, the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General),
 Water Resources Department, Chennai has now stated as follows:-
 - The Government have accorded Administrative Sanction for Phase VIII-100 works for an amount of Rs.8377.04 lakh and Revised Administrative Sanction for Rs.9282.98 lakh.
 - ii) The fund details are as follows:-

iii) So far, an expenditure of Rs.4526.83 lakh has been incurred. Out of 100 works, 34 works have been completed and balance works are under progress. In order to obtain balance central assistance, it is mandatory to furnish G.O declaring that the water body boundary is free from encroachment.

- iv) As per clause 3.3 (g) of the RRR Guidelines 2022 and Memorandum of Understanding (Annexure VI Release of Central Assistance viii) "State Government is to take necessary steps for declaring the water body boundary through Government order and to ensure removal of encroachments in the water body spread area / water body boundary before submitting the proposal for release of 2nd instalment of grant for completion of work on the water body.
- 4. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai has also furnished the following details in respect of 100 water bodies taken up under phase VIII of PMKSY:-
 - Encroachment certificates authenticated by the Chief Engineer, Chennai Region (26 tanks) / Madurai Region (44 tanks) / Trichy Region (30 tanks).
 - ii. Statement of Area encroached in form-I of Appendix of the Tamil Nadu Protection of Tanks and Eviction of Encroachment Rules 2007.
 - iii. A notice showing the index map of the tank and its boundaries (along with the details of boundaries marked in the map) notified in the form II in Appendix of the Tamil Nadu Protection of Tanks and Eviction of Encroachment Rules 2007.
- 5. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai has therefore requested the Government to accord the approval for declaring that 100 water bodies taken up in Phase VIII of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY), HKKP (Har Khet Ko Pani) are free from any kind of encroachment.
- 6. Based on the details furnished by the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai, the Government have decided to declare that 100 water bodies in Phase VIII of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY), HKKP (Har Khet Ko Pani) are free from any kind of encroachment.
