



## **ABSTRACT**

Water Resources Department - Construction of Check Dam across the Palar River near Ullavur (Palayaseevaram) Village in Walajabad Taluk of Kancheepuram District- Revised Administrative Sanction for of Rs.4544.00 Lakh – Accorded – Orders issued.

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### **ORDER:**

In the Government Order 1<sup>st</sup> read above, the Government have accorded administrative sanction for construction of a Check Dam across Palar river near Ullavur (Palayaseevaram) Village in Walajabad Taluk of Kancheepuram District at a cost of Rs.4216.11 lakh, in which a sum of Rs.4005.30 lakh to be borne by NABARD Loan assistance and Rs.210.81 lakh from State Fund.

2. In the letter second read above, the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai has sent a Revised Administrative Sanction proposal for Construction of Check Dam across Palar River near Ullavur (Palayaseevaram) Village in Walajabad Taluk of Kancheepuram District at a revised cost of Rs.4544.00 lakh as follows:

- a) The Chief Engineer, Chennai Region had accorded technical sanction for the above Work for Rs.4216.11 lakh vide Registration

No.31CECR/ 2019-20 and tenders were called for and the Lowest tender of M/s PPS Construction, Madurai was approved by the Tender Award Committee during its 346<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 08.07.2020 for Rs.4424.17 lakh with a tender premium of Rs.327.89 lakh or (+) 8.00% excess over the departmental value put to tender.

- b) The Chief Engineer, Water Resources Department, Chennai Region has informed that the reason for the Revised Administrative Sanction is only due to the excess of Tender Premium of Rs.327.89 lakh and requested to obtain necessary approval of the competent authorities.
- c) The Revised Administrative Sanction proposal had been placed before the 53<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of the Technical Advisory Committee held on 30.07.2021 and the Committee had recommended this proposal to the Tender Award Committee for Rs.4544.00 lakh.
- d) The above proposal had also been placed before the 381<sup>st</sup> Meeting of the Tender Award Committee held on 14.09.2021 and the Committee had also recommended this proposal to Government for Rs.4544.00 lakh with an excess of Rs.327.89 lakh over and above the Administrative Sanction of Rs.4216.11 lakh.

The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai has therefore requested to accord Revised Administrative Sanction for construction of Check Dam across Palar river near Ullavur (Palayaseevaram) Village in Walajabad Taluk of Kancheepuram District for value of Rs.4544.00 lakh in which Rs.327.89 lakh is excess over the original administrative sanctioned amount of Rs.4216.11 lakh.

4. The Government after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department, Chennai. Accordingly, Revised Administrative Sanction is accorded for construction of a Check Dam across Palar river near Ullavur (Palayaseevaram) Village in Walajabad Taluk of Kancheepuram District for an amount of Rs.4544.00 lakh (Rupees Forty five crore and forty four lakh only) against the original administrative sanction amount of Rs.4216.11 lakh in which Rs.327.89 lakh (Rupees Three Crore twenty seven lakh and eighty nine thousand only) excess over the administrative sanction amount.

5. The expenditure sanctioned at para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:

"4700 - Capital Outlay on Major Irrigation -  
03 - Palar Basin - 800 - Other Expenditure -  
State's Expenditure - DB - Weir - NABARD Assistance -  
416 Major works - 01 Major works.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Services" and approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be met by drawal of an Advance from the Contingency Fund. The Engineer-In-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai-5, is directed to send necessary proposals to the Government in Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules,1963 along with copy of this order for sanction of an Advance from the Contingency Fund. Orders regarding which will be issued by Finance (BG-I) Department separately. He is also directed to send necessary Explanatory Notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2022 - 2023 to Finance (PW-II / BG-I) Department at an appropriate time without fail.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O. No.19018/PW-II/2022, dated.25.04.2022 with Additional Sanction Ledger No.70 (seventy).
