ORDER:

In the letter read above, the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department has sent a proposal for Reconstruction of Reinforced Cement Concrete Bridge across AVM Canal near Marthandamthurai in Kollancode-B Village at Killiyoor Taluk of Kanniyakumari District at an estimate amount of Rs.34.30 lakh for obtaining Administrative Sanction based on the representation given by Thiru S.Rajeshkumar, MLA., of Killiyoor Constituency.

2. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai has stated that Marthandamthurai is located between Kollancode and Vallavilai. The existing bridge is located in between Marthandamthurai Church and Marthandamthurai Primary Health Center at AVM Canal which is a very old bridge (more than 50 years) and is in damaged and dilapidated condition. People are experiencing difficulty in crossing the AVM Canal through this bridge. In the past 5 years, there has been no movement of vehicles through this bridge. Hence, it is essential to construct a new bridge across AVM canal for effective use by the Public. The above estimate was prepared based

on the Schedule of Rates for the year 2020 – 2021 and work out to Rs.34.30 lakh.

- 3.The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department has therefore requested the Government to accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.34.30 Crore for Reconstruction of Reinforced Cement Concrete Bridge across AVM Canal near Marthandamthurai in Kollancode-B Village at Killiyoor Taluk of Kanniyakumari District.
- 4. The Government after careful examination, have decided to accept the above proposal of the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai and accord administrative and financial sanction for Reconstruction of Reinforced Cement Concrete Bridge across AVM Canal near Marthandamthurai in Kollancode-B Village at Killiyoor Taluk of Kanniyakumari District at an estimated cost of Rs.34,20,089/- (Rupees Thirty four lakh twenty thousand and eighty nine only) as detailed below:

- 5. It is also ordered that execution of the above Work should be done by Highways and Minor Ports Department as a deposit work by waiving Centage Charges.
- 6. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai is directed to take necessary action to hand over the above Work to Highways Department for execution of the above work as a deposit work as ordered in para 4 and 5 above by following the procedures.

- 7. Highways and Minor Port Department is directed to take necessary action to execute the above Work as a deposit work as ordered in para 4 and 5 above.
- 8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:- (40-01)

4702 - 00 - Capital Outlay on Minor Irrigation - 101 - Surface Water - State's Expenditure - AD - Kodaiyar Basin - Water Courses - 416 - Major Works - 01 Major Works.

- 9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Services" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be met by drawal of an Advance from the Contingency Fund, orders will be issued by Finance (BG-I) Department separately. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai is directed to send necessary proposals to Government in Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 with a copy of this order for sanction of an Advance from the Contingency Fund. He is also directed to send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2022 2023 to Finance (PW-II / BG-I) Department at an appropriate time.
- 10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.41400/PW-II/02, dated.15.09.2022 and the Additional Sanction Ledger No.1237 (One thousand Two hundred and thirty seven) (IFHRMS ASL No.2022091237).
