**ORDER:**

In the Government Order 1<sup>st</sup> read above, orders have been issued for enhancing the Messing Allowance in respect of ANO and Officer Cadets from Rs.95/- to Rs.213/- per day per head during Pre-Commission / Refresher Training Courses with the entire expenditure for the same is borne by Government of Tamil Nadu out of which 50% will be reimbursed from Central Government through CDA.

2. In the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Ministry of Defence, Government of India had instructed to the Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps that the expenditure on Messing Allowance for Pre-Commission Training Course / Refresher Training Courses henceforth be shared between Central and State Government at 50:50 basis.

3. In the letter 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, the Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps has informed the Government that presently the funding pattern for expenditure on Pre-Commission Training Course and Refresher Training Course of ANO's from Army/Navy/Air being followed now at 100% share of State Government expenditure will henceforth be met out by the State Government at 50% share and the balance 50% share will be borne by Central Government for Messing Allowance of ANOs / Officer Cadets. Consequent to the above change

in funding pattern, the financial burden to the State Exchequer will be reduced and its details are furnished below:-

Total Expenditure Sanctioned by the Government under the Head for "72 training" for messing allowance (100% share of Expenditure, now borne by State Government)	Rs.14,16,000/-
Central Government Share of expenditure @ 50% hence forth to be followed	Rs. 7,08,000/-
State Government Share of expenditure @ 50% hence forth to be followed	Rs. 7,08,000/-

4. The Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps has requested the Government for administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.7,08,000/- towards the State Government share of 50% for Messing Allowance in respect of ANO and Officer Cadets for Pre-commission Training Course / Refresher Training Courses in the expenditure ratio of 50:50 between the State Government and Central Government under the head "72 Training" from the year 2018-19.

5. The Government after careful consideration, accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.7,08,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh and Eight Thousand only) towards the State Government share of 50% for Messing Allowance in respect of ANO and officer Cadets for Pre-commission Training Course / Refresher Training Courses in the expenditure ratio of 50:50 between the State Government and Central Government under the head "72 Training".

6. The Expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:


