### ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government has issued orders for revising the rates of Rank pay to Associate National Cadet Corps Officers in National Cadet Corps Department is as follows:-

2. In the letter second read above, the Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps Directorate, Chennai had taken up a case with Government towards revision of rate of Rank pay to Associate National Cadet Corps Officers vide letter dated 05.12.2011 as detailed below:

3. The Government had communicated its consent for the proposed revision in the rate of Rank Pay to the Associate National Cadet Corps Officers (ANOs) with prospective effect and an additional expenditure of Rs.83,62,464/- per annum to the State and further intimated to obtain and communicate the sanction of Government of India with its financial assistance so as to revise the rate of Rank Pay to the Associate National Cadet Corps Officers vide Government letter third read above.

4. In the letter fifth read above, the Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps has stated that the Government of India, Ministry of Defence, New Delhi in his letter dated 24.07.2015 has conveyed the sanction of competent authority for revision in the rate of Rank pay to Associate National Cadet Corps Officers at the rates detailed below:-

5 . The Under Secretary, Ministry of Defence, Government of India have further ordered that the expenditure on pay of Rank during trekking / mountaineering expeditions, National Cadet Corps camps and training courses will be borne as indicated below:-

(b)	Camps	75% by the Central Government and 25% by State Govts/UTAs
(c)	Camps/Training courses in r/o ANOs of J&K, NER States & Sikkim	100% by Central Government
(d)	Training courses in r/o other States /UTAs	100% by respective State Government/UTA

6. The Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps has requested the Government to revise the Rank Pay to the Associate National Cadet Corps Officers during the current year (i.e.2015-16) at the cost of an additional expenditure of Rs.15,48,124/- (Rupees fifteen lakhs forty eight thousand one hundred and twenty four only) instead of Rs.83,62,464/- (Rupees eighty three lakhs sixty two thousand four hundred and sixty four only) as mentioned in Government letter No.3344/YW1/2011-2 dated 30.07.2012 and also the additional expenditure of Rs.15,48,124/- (Rupees fifteen lakhs forty eight thousand one hundred and twenty four only) may be provided in the Revised Estimate 2015-16.

7. Further he has stated that the expenditure on Rank Pay to the Associate National Cadet Corps Officers who are detailed to attend the Annual Training Camp, other Camps (including attachments) will be 75:25 basis. The Rank Pay to the Associate National Cadet Corps Officers who are detailed to the Training Courses (Refresher courses etc) will be 100% by the State Government. The State Government share towards payment in regard to Financial implication based on actual attendance of Associate National Cadet Corps Officers for Training Course and Camps are detailed in Annexure I & II.

8. The Government after careful examination sanction an additional amount of Rs.15,48,124 (Rupees fifteen lakhs forty eight thousand one hundred and twenty four only) towards revision of Rank pay to Associate National Cadet Corps Officers in National Cadet Corps Department, who attend training courses and camps as per the pattern of sharing to be borne by Government of Tamil Nadu as mentioned in Annexure I & II. The said revision will take effect from 01.04.2016.

9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 8 above shall be debited under the following head of account:-
