ORDER

In the Government order first read above, Government have issued orders revising the Monthly Honorarium to Associate National Cadet Corps Officers (ANOs) with effect from 20.07.2006 as detailed below:

2. Further the Government have instructed National Cadet Corps Department to send a detailed report with regard to increase of honorarium to the Associate National Cadet Corps Officers based on a letter written by the Hon'ble Minister of State for Defence, Government of India, New Delhi, vide its letter dated 08.09.2009. Accordingly, National Cadet Corps Directorate, Chennai had taken up a case with Government towards revision of honorarium as detailed below:

3. The State Government have communicated the consent for the proposed revision in the rate of honorarium to the Associate National Cadet Corps (ANOs) with effect from the academic year 2012-13 at an additional expenditure of Rs.135.66 lakhs per annum (approximate). The State Government have further requested to obtain and communicate the orders of the Government of India for revision in the rate of honorarium to the Associate National Cadet Corps officers.

4. The Under Secretary, Ministry of Defence, Government of India in his letter dated 24.07.2015 had conveyed the sanction of the competent authority for

revision in the rates of Honorarium admissible to Associate National Cadet Corps Officers at the rates given below:-

5. The Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps has stated that Government of India has stated that the expenditure towards payment of honorarium will be shared in the ratio of 50:50 between the Central and State Governments concerned. Earlier it was fully funded (100%) by the State Government.

6. Consequent to change in funding pattern, the financial burden to the State Exchequer will be reduced and its details are furnished below:

The Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps has requested the Government to sanction an additional amount of Rs.67,83,000/- (Rupees sixty seven lakhs eighty three thousand only) towards enhancement of monthly honorarium paid to the ANOs in the National Cadet Corps Department. Further he has stated that consequent to the revision in the rates of honorarium the total budget estimate for the year 2016-17 would be Rs.1,10,23,800/- (Rupees one crore ten lakhs twenty three thousand eight hundred only). The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps to enhance the rates of allowance to ANOs and to accord sanction for an additional expenditure for a sum of Rs.25,42,200/- per annum (Rupees twenty five lakhs forty two thousand and two hundred only) towards revision of the monthly honorarium paid to the ANOs in National Cadet Corps Department and also ordered that this revision shall take effect from 01.04.2016.

9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 8 above shall be debited under the following head of account:


