ORDER:

In Government Order first read above, the Government has accorded administrative sanction for the construction of Multipurpose Indoor Stadium with the facilities of gallery, wooden floor and lighting arrangements in 20 districts at an estimated cost of Rs.150.00 lakhs each with work to be taken up in 5 districts during the year 2011-12. Government also sanctioned a non-recurring grant of Rs.7.50 Crore (Rupees Seven Crore and Fifty Lakhs only) as first phase to the Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu for the work mentioned above. Accordingly the Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu has taken up the construction of the Multipurpose Indoor Stadium in Ariyalur, Coimbatore, Kanchipuram, Trichy (Srirangam) and Villupuram and the works are almost completed except in Coimbatore.

2. Subsequently in Government Order second read above, the Government have sanctioned a non recurring grant of Rs.750.00 lakhs for construction of 5 Multipurpose Indoor Stadium in 5 districts as 2nd phase at a cost of Rs.150.00 lakhs each for the year 2012-13. Accordingly the Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu has taken up the construction of the Multipurpose Indoor

Stadium in Dindigul, Kanniyakumari, Madurai, Thanjavur and Thoothukudi and the works are in advanced stage.

- 3. In this connection the Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu has stated that nowadays, most of the games are played in Indoor Stadium where sports persons can undergo training for longer sessions irrespective of the weather conditions. Besides that, competitions can also be conducted throughout the year. Further, many disciplines can be played under one roof which would eventually benefit sports persons of varied disciplines. Hence, it is considered necessary that the benefit of playing in Indoor Stadium is extended to more number of districts.
- 4. The Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu has further stated that with regard to the sanction of Multipurpose Indoor Stadium in the third phase, the following five districts may be considered:
 - 1. Namakkal
 - 2. Nagapattinam
 - 3. Perambalur
 - 4. Pudukottai
 - 5. Virudhunagar

He has also furnished the justification report received from the District Collectors for the Districts mentioned above at SI.Nos.1-3 and his own feasibility reports at SI.Nos.4 & 5.

- 5. Besides, the Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu has informed that sufficient land is available and is in possession of Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu in Namakkal, Nagapattinam, Pudukottai and Virudhunagar Districts. As far as, Perambalur is concerned the land selected by the District Collector may be considered since it is located in the heart of the Perambalur Town.
- 6. In view of the reasons stated above, the Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu has requested the Government to issue necessary orders for the construction of Multipurpose Indoor Stadium in five districts viz. Namakkal, Nagapattinam, Perambalur, Pudukkottai and Virudhunagar at a cost of Rs.150.00 lakhs each and sanction Rs.750.00 lakhs for the year 2013-14.
- 7. The Government after careful examination, accord sanction a non recurring grant of Rs.7,50,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Crore and Fifty Lakhs only) for construction of Multipurpose Indoor Stadium in five districts, viz. Namakkal, Nagapattinam, Perambalur, Pudukkottai and virudhunagar at a cost of Rs.1,50,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore and Fifty Lakhs only) each in 3rd phase for the year 2013-14.

8. The expenditure sanctioned above shall be debited to the following Head of account:-

2204 00 Sports and Youth Services 104. Sports and Games – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan-II. State Plan-JW. Grants to Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu for Establishment of Sports Complex-09. Grants-in-Aid-02. Grants for Capital Expenditure" (DPC 2204 00 104 JW 0927)

- 9. The expenditure sanctioned above shall constitute an item of 'New Instrument of Service' and approval of the Legislature will be obtained in the due course of time. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure shall initially be met by an advance from the Contingency Fund, orders regarding which will be issued by the Government in Finance (BG-I) Department based on the application for sanction of advance required for the current financial year received from the Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu in the prescribed format along with a copy of this order to Finance (BG-I) Department. He is also requested to send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2014-15 without fail.
- 10. The Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu subject to para 9 alone shall prepare the bill and present it in the Pay and Accounts Office, Secretariat, Chennai-9 through the Under Secretary to Government, Youth Welfare and Sports Development Department, Chennai. The above sanctioned amount shall not be paid in cash but shall be credited into the following Head of account:-

"K Deposits and Advances (B) Deposits not bearing interest-8443 00 Civil Deposits-800 Other Deposits-CH Deposits of Sports Development Authority (DPC 8443 00 800 CH 000D)" by means of Cheque / Demand Draft drawn in favour of PD Account No.6184513932.
