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PREFACE

Public Works Department is one of the oldest Service Departments of the Government, serving for the past 153 years in the construction and maintenance of Government Buildings.

Many buildings and monuments stand as testimony to our engineering skill. The organization marches towards better service delivery to the people by adopting to the present day trend of egovernance. The Department is taking all efforts for better service delivery with this long term vision.

The Buildings Organisation provides structural safety to all public buildings adopting latest technology and following specifications of Indian Standard Code.

All the Monuments and Heritage buildings under the control of Government are being protected by PWD by keeping their Architectural, Aesthetic, Historic, archeological and prominent symbolic values.

This department has long term vision for quality service for safe and purposeful public buildings at reasonable cost adopting best evolved practices and advanced modern technologies.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

BUILDINGS

1.0. GENERAL

The Public Works Department Buildings Organization constructs and maintains buildings of various Government Departments like School Education, Health & Family Welfare, Home (Judicial, Transport, Prison, Fire & Rescue), Revenue, Agriculture, Husbandry, Animal Dairying Fisheries, Tourism & Art Culture Department, Labour & Employment and Social Welfare Department.

Public Works Department provides quality services for Safe Government buildings at reasonable cost utilizing modern technologies and experience attained through years of practice. Public Works Department follows the designs and specifications stipulated in the Indian Standard Codes.

1.1. MAJOR ACTIVITIES

Public Works Department performs the following major activities and functions:

- Planning, designing, construction and maintenance of Government Buildings which constitute capital assets of the State.
- Construction and maintenance of Monuments and Memorials under purview of the Government.
- Execution of Local Area Development Scheme works sanctioned under MLAs' and MPs' funds as deposit works.
- Execution of any calamity reconstruction works like Emergency Tsunami Reconstruction Project building works.
- Renovation and restoration of heritage buildings.

- Construction of buildings for Central Government Undertakings, State Universities etc., as deposit works.
- Carrying out Research and Development in construction materials and practices.
- Valuation of buildings was done based on the requests of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption Department and Judiciary.
- Assessment of structural stability of public buildings and issuance of rent reasonableness certificate for private buildings used by Government departments.

1.2. NEW BUILDING MATERIALS

Collection, dissemination of updated technology and new building materials are approved by the Assessment Committee constituted by the Government comprising of various members from Academic, Research and Execution Departments. Effective steps are being taken for adopting approved new building materials in the Construction and Maintenance of Public buildings.

1.3. QUALITY TESTING

Tamizhaga Arasu Building Research Station is functioning at Chennai to carry out quality tests on concrete by compression testing machine and non destructive testing equipments as per the Bureau of Indian Standard codal provisions.

1.4. CONSULTANCY

All type of Building Consultancy Services i.e. Planning, Estimating and Structural designing for Quasi Governmental organizations and also for private buildings are undertaken by Public Works Department Kattida Maiyam with a nominal specified charges.

1.5. NEW WING FOR MEDICAL BUILDING CONSTRUCTION & MAINTENANCE WORKS

As per the directions of the Hon'ble Chief Minister, a separate wing for the Health and Family Welfare Department will be created. This wing will contain three circles and will exclusively look after the construction and maintenance works pertaining to the Health and Family Welfare Department.

1.6. STANDARD SCHEDULE OF RATES, 2011-2012

In order to assess the value of the estimates of construction prepared by the Government Departments, the Public Works Department behalf of the on Government of Tamil Nadu finalises and releases the Standard Schedule of Rates every year based on the approval by a Committee constituted by the Government.

For the first time in the history of approval of Standard Schedule of Rates, this year (2011-2012) it is being adopted from 01.07.2011, considering the labour rates, material cost and transportation expenditure for conveying the building materials, etc., prevailing in the open market. The Committee have increased the Rates of labour by 25%, Materials such as, bricks and tile products by 25%, stone jelly, steel by 10% over the previous year 2010-2011 and also

increased the transportation charges substantially duly taking into account the actual increase in cost of fuel, in the past period.

3.11. TOURISM AND CULTURE DEPARTMENT

3.11.1. Memorials

3.11.1.1. Perarignar Anna Memorial

Memorial for the historic leader of Dravidian Movement Dr. C.N.Annadurai, popularly known as "Perarignar Anna", was constructed on the Marina beach in an extent of 11.20 acres in the year 1973. In this memorial, now it is proposed to carry out the renovation works like raising compound wall, the providing stainless steel hand rails, renovation of front side flooring, renovation of lawns and sprinklers.

3.11.1.2. Bharat Ratna Dr. M.G.R. Memorial

Bharat Ratna Dr.M.G.R. known as "Puratchi Thalaivar" and "Makkal Thilagam" among the mass of people, is one of the most popular Leader of Dravidian movement. Memorial and to add landscaping, fountains etc.
