Public Works Department is vested with the onerous responsibility of creating the infrastructure

that facilitates economic growth and enhances the quality of lives of the people of the State.

Public Works Department has been ably conceptualising and delivering the infrastructure that realises the vision of the Government. The department takes up the construction of buildings for various departments required for a variety of purposes. These projects are designed to be functional, sturdy, compliant with statutory requirements and aesthetic in appearance.

Realising the need for and importance of the construction and maintenance of public buildings the Public Works Department was created in 1858 and has been functioning for more than 165 vears, making it the one of the oldest departments in the State. It is the parent department for all engineering departments in the technical expertise State. With and skilled

manpower, it creates and maintains public infrastructure in the state.

The work of the department includes construction of public buildings such as hospitals, medical colleges, schools, courts and offices for Revenue, Commercial Tax, Transport, Registration departments.

Heritage buildings are being conserved and renovated by using the scientific principles of conservation, preserving our heritage and culture for future generations.

This department is executing works using latest construction materials and deploying advanced technologies. It adheres to standards laid down by the Bureau of Indian Standards, National Building Code and other applicable codes. Buildings are disabled friendly, environmentally sustainable and promote energy conservation.

All official procedures such as preparation of estimates, calling for tenders, monitoring of

building progress, payment of bills etc., have been computerised to ensure efficiency and ease of working.

"தரமே தாரக மந்திரம்" All the buildings are constructed with utmost care and to prescribed quality standards by Public Works Department. Separate quality control divisions have been formed in all the 4 regions of the State to ensure this. In all construction sites, site inspections, lab tests are being carried out by the quality control engineers and defects if any noticed are being rectified instantly.

For creating aesthetic and functional public buildings, exclusive wings such as Architect wing, Planning and Designs circle, Building Centre and Conservation divisions, Electrical divisions, Quality control divisions have been formed and are functional.

During natural disasters, the department swiftly responds by ensuring that critical infrastructure

like Collectorates and hospitals remain functional and takes up immediate restoration of damaged infrastructure.

All arrangements for V.I.P and V.V.I.P visits and arrangements for the smooth conduct of Government functions are being handled by this department.

3.0 MAINTENANCE OF GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS

3.1. BUILDINGS OWNED BY PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

Budget Estimates for 2024-2025 under Public Works Department, Demand No.39 an amount of ₹165.33 Cr. is allocated towards maintenance and repair works in Government bungalows occupied by the Hon'ble Ministers, Inspection bungalows, Circuit houses, Public Works Department office buildings and Government staff quarters.

3.2. OTHER DEPARTMENT BUILDINGS

Budget Estimates for 2024-2025 under other Heads, an amount of ₹ 584.58 Cr. is allotted towards maintenance and repair works in the Governor's bungalow, Secretariat buildings, High Court buildings, District and other Subordinate Court buildings, Government bungalows occupied by the Hon'ble High Court Judges, M.L.A. Offices, Hospitals, Medical Colleges, Primary Health Centres, Health Sub Centres, Schools, Revenue

and Disaster Management Department buildings, Agriculture and Farmer Welfare buildings, Registration office buildings and other Government buildings.

4.0. KALAIGNAR CENTENARY PROJECTS

4.1. MUTHAMIZH ARIGNAR DR. KALAIGNAR MEMORIAL LIBRARY

As per the announcement of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 03.06.2021, the **Muthamizh Arignar Dr. Kalaignar Memorial Library** has been constructed at an estimated cost of ₹120.75 Cr. at Madurai. The library was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 15.07.2023 in the presence of the Hon'ble Minister for Public works, Highways and Minor Ports and other Ministers.

This magnificent library building with an area of 2,00,250 square feet is spread over ground and six floors. The library leverages modern technology to create a good learning

environment. It has a variety of sections viz. rare books section, competitive exam books section, and children books section, digital library. It has special sections for the visually-challenged and differently-abled. Supporting facilities such as elevators, escalators, and ramps make it easy for the elderly, children, and the disabled to access all floors of the library building.

4.2. KALAIGNAR MULTI SUPER SPECIALITY HOSPITAL AT GUINDY, CHENNAI

Based on the announcement of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 03.06.2021 the **Kalaignar Multi Super Specialty Hospital** was constructed in the premises of the King Institute of Preventive Medicine and Research, Guindy, Chennai. The hospital was inaugurated by Hon'ble Chief Minister, Tamil Nadu on 15.06.2023 and dedicated to the public.

Built in 4.89 acres of land, at an estimated cost of ₹240.53 Cr. It is spread over an area of

51,429 sqm on ground and six floors. The Hospital has 1000 beds, in three blocks. Block A has Outpatient block and administration building. Block B has Operation theatre complex and Intensive Care Unit. Block C has 15 Operation theatres, 175 ICU beds and is equipped with investigations like CT and MRI.

4.3 KALAIGNAR CENTENARY AERUTHAZUVUTHAL ARENA

The announcement of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 21.01.2022 to construct a Jallikattu Arena at Keelakarai village in Madurai District was implemented in an area of 66 acres at an estimated cost of ₹62.78 Cr. The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu inaugurated the **Kalaignar Centenary Aeruthazuvuthal Arena** and flagged of the first aeruthazuvuthal event on 24.01.2024. The event started off with the first bull charging out of the Vaadivasal. The first event was conducted with 482 bulls and 259 bull tamers. The bulls and participants came from 19 districts. Winners were awarded various prizes.

The Arena has a seating capacity of 4500, a museum, rooms for guests, dormitories for participants, Veterinary Dispensary, 2 bull sheds, Bull burn, health sub centre, toilet blocks, entrance arch, approach road, lawns and gardens, firefighting arrangements, OHT and pump room, lighting arrangements etc.,

4.4. MEMORIAL FOR MUTHAMIZH ARIGNAR KALAIGNAR

The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 24.08.2021 announced that a memorial will be constructed for Hon'ble former Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu Muthamizh Arignar Kalaignar M. Karunanidhi. The construction of the memorial in an area of 2.21 acres in the Perarignar Anna Memorial campus on Kamarajar Salai, Chennai at an estimated cost of ₹53.73 Cr. has been completed.

The memorial was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 26.02.2024. The memorial complex houses a museum **'Kalaignar Ulagam'** which showcases the life, times and achievements of one of the greatest leaders of the country. The museum is built at an estimated cost of ₹47.75 Cr.

5.0 ICONIC PROJECTS

5.1 NEW STUDENTS HOSTEL AT M.C. RAJA HOSTEL CAMPUS, NANDANAM, CHENNAI

The work of construction of a new Hostel building with modern facilities at M.C. Raja Hostel Campus, Nandanam, Chennai at an estimated cost of ₹44.50 Cr. is in progress. The building with ground and 10 floors has 121 rooms that can accommodate 484 students. 5.2. RENOVATION OF VALLUVAR KOTTAM, CHENNAI

Valluvar Kottam was created by the then Chief Minister Muthamizh Arignar Kalaignar during the year 1974-1976 to reflect Dravidian culture, heritage and architecture. The renovation and retrofitting is being taken up at an estimated cost of ₹80.00 Cr.

The renovated complex will be an air-conditioned State-of-the-art convention venue that can host cultural and social events. It will have a museum about the Thirukkural. It will be landscaped with gardens and illuminated to become a popular public attraction. It will have modern facilities, a new library, seminar rooms sound and light show, cafeteria and other public amenities.

6.0 CONSERVATION, RENOVATION AND RESTORATION OF HERITAGE BUILDINGS

Preservation of Heritage buildings for historical, architectural, cultural & aesthetic reasons is

essential for future generations to appreciate and learn from their past.

The Building centre and conservation division takes up conservation, renovation and restoration of heritage buildings by following scientific principles of conservation antiquity.

Heritage buildings such as Humayun Mahal, Kalas Mahal in Chepauk, Egmore Court, Egmore Museum, Little theatre, National art gallery, the Madras High Court building and the head office of the Public Works Department have been renovated by the Public Works Department.

Renovation works are in progress at Deputy Inspector General of Registration office building on Rajaji road and Government Central Press at Mint street in Chennai, old Governor's House and Kuthiraivandi Court building at Coimbatore, Old Labour Court building at Salem, Old District Collector's Office (Rani Mangammal Palace) at Tiruchirappalli and Kohinoor - Sheik Abdullah Bungalow at Kodaikanal.

Conservation, renovation and restoration works of 17 heritage buildings in various districts at an estimated cost of ₹103.74 Cr. are under implementation for the year 2022-2023.

Conservation, renovation and restoration works of 8 heritage buildings at an estimated cost of ₹49.76 Cr. in various districts are under implementation by the Public Works Department for the year 2023-2024.

7.0 MEMORIALS AND MONUMENTS

Memorials / Monuments are constructed and maintained by Public Works Department in various places of Tamil Nadu in memory of freedom fighters, eminent scholars, great leaders etc.,

8.0. DEPARTMENT-WISE BUILDING WORKS

8.1. ANIMAL HUSBANDRY, DAIRYING, FISHERIES AND FISHERMEN WELFARE DEPARTMENT

Construction of Veterinary hospitals, Veterinary dispensaries, Clinician centres, Animal Diseases and Intelligence Unit for Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Department is being taken up with NABARD assistance, at various places across Tamil Nadu.

10 works at an estimated cost of ₹203.78 Cr. were completed for the establishment of **Advanced Institute for Integrated Research on Livestock & Animal Sciences (AIIRLIVAS)** in Salem District.

115 works including construction of Veterinary dispensaries, Veterinary hospital, Clinician centres and Animal Disease Intelligence Units have been completed at an estimated cost of ₹79.16 Cr. 49 works at an estimated cost of ₹40.15 Cr. are in

progress and 7 works at an estimated cost of ₹4.65 Cr. will be taken up shortly.

8.2. BACKWARD CLASSES, MOST BACKWARD CLASSES & MINORITIES WELFARE DEPARTMENT

510 building construction works & repair works have been taken up and they include

- Hostel buildings with Solar energy systems,
- Special maintenance & repair works in Minority welfare hostels
- Special maintenance & repair works in Most backward classes hostels, Backward classes hostels & DNC Hostels
- Construction of additional class rooms, additional toilets, compound wall and bore wells to Kallar Elementary / Middle / High / Higher Secondary Schools with NABARD assistance.
- Construction of Zonal office buildings for Waqf Board

- Special maintenance & repair works in Minority Welfare hostels
- Special maintenance & repair works in Kallar schools

399 works at an estimated cost of ₹112.16 Cr. have been completed. 43 works are in progress at an estimated cost of ₹82.13 Cr. 68 works will be taken up shortly at an estimated cost of ₹10.90 Cr.

8.3. CO-OPERATION, FOOD AND CONSUMER PROTECTION DEPARTMENT

Construction works of Co-operative banks, Co-operative Master plan complex and Co-operative Training Institute are being carried out by the Public Works Department.

The work of construction of Cooperative Arts & Science College at Athur taluk in Dindigul district at an estimated cost of ₹75.75 Cr. is in progress. The construction of a new building for National level Institute of Cooperative Studies, Research

and Training at Mannavanur Village in Kodaikanal taluk, Dindigul District at an estimated cost of ₹126 Cr. will be taken up after site is handed over.

8.4. COMMERCIAL TAXES AND REGISTRATION DEPARTMENT

Buildings for Commercial Tax offices, Integrated Commercial Tax offices, Integrated Registration offices and Sub-Registrar offices are constructed and maintained by Public Works Department.

82 works including construction of Integrated Commercial Taxes office building, Renovation of heritage buildings, Integrated Sub Registrar office buildings, Integrated Registration office complex and Deputy Inspector General camp office buildings are being taken up at an estimated cost of ₹ 206.74 Cr.

16 works at an estimated cost of ₹60.12 Cr. are completed. 55 works at an estimated cost of ₹122.64 Cr. are in progress and 11 works at an

estimated cost of ₹23.98 Cr. will be taken up shortly.

8.5. ENVIRONMENT, CLIMATE CHANGE AND FORESTS DEPARTMENT

Construction works pertaining to Forest Department are being carried out by the Public Works Department such as Forest Department head office and laboratories, etc.

In respect of Environment, Climate Change and Forests Department, construction of District Environmental Engineer's office and laboratory for Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board in Thalavaipatti at Salem District at an estimated cost of ₹6.42 Cr. is in progress.

8.6. HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE DEPARTMENT

Construction of new Government medical college hospital, institutional and residential buildings at Udhagamandalam at an estimated cost of ₹461.18 Cr. are in the final stages of completion.

With the financial assistance of Japan International Co-operation Agency (JICA), 3 new Tertiary care hospital buildings at Chennai, Coimbatore, Madurai and 4 new Secondary care hospital buildings at Tiruvallur, Salem, Tiruppur Tirunelveli are being constructed and with international standards at an estimated cost of ₹615.00 Cr. 2 Tertiary care hospital buildings and 3 Secondary care hospital buildings works are completed and 1 Secondary care and 1 Tertiary care hospital building works will be completed shortly and put into public use.

Other medical buildings that are being constructed at an estimated cost of ₹140.10 Cr. are

 OP block, Dialysis ward and Ophthalmic ward at Government Head Quarters hospital at Usilampatti in Madurai District. Work completed.

- Multi Super Specialty hospital in Government Head Quarters hospital at Erode in Erode District. Work completed.
- Additional floor over the existing G+3 floors in the campus of Institute of Social Obstetrics and Government Kasturba Gandhi Hospital for Women and Children, Triplicane, Chennai. Work completed.
- New Government Dental College and hospital at Pudukottai in Pudukottai District. Work is in progress.

8.6.1. NATIONAL HEALTH MISSION

Construction of Primary health centres, Health sub centres, Maternal and Child health wing buildings (MCH), Comprehensive Emergency Obstetric and New Born Care Centre (CEMONC), staff nurse quarters, outpatient wards and emergency care unit buildings are being constructed with National Health Mission funds. Additional buildings are being constructed for 19 Government hospitals at Jeyamkondam, Tambaram, Palani, Thirukovilur, Karur, Hosur, Mayiladuthurai, Vedaranyam, Rasipuram, Aranthangi, Paramakudi, Gudalur, Tiruttani, Valliyur, Tirupathur, Kangeyam, Gudiyatham, Tindivanam and Arupukottai for upgrading them as District headquarters hospitals at an estimated cost of ₹856.85 Cr. and works are in progress.

Construction of buildings for upgradation of 5 Government hospitals at Kulithalai, Thiruchengodu, Ambasamudram, Dharapuram and Rajapalayam on par with District Head Quarters hospital has been taken up at an estimated cost of ₹142.00 Cr and works are in progress.

12 District Integrated Public Health Laboratories are being established in Government hospitals at Tambaram, Saidapet, Pollachi, Chidambaram, Palani, Usilampatti, Cheyyar, Valliyur,

Manapparai, Mettur, Tiruttani and Tirupattur at an estimated cost of ₹15.00 Cr. Of 12 works, 6 works completed, 5 works in progress and Palani work to be taken up.

The Foundation stone was laid by Hon'ble Chief Minister on 22.12.2022 for the construction of Centre of Excellence building for Tamil Nadu Institute of Mental Health and Neurosciences (TNIMHANS) at Institute of Mental Health, Kilpauk, Chennai at an estimated cost of ₹35.00 Cr. and work is in progress.

Construction of Maternal and Child Health building at Kilpauk Medical college hospital, Saidapet Government hospital, Kasturba Gandhi Maternity hospital, RSRM Government hospital, Tiruvannamalai Government hospital, Thanjavur Raja Mirasdar Government hospital, Lalgudi Government hospital, Chidambaram Government Medical College hospital, Government hospital Pattukottai, Cumbum, Pennagaram, Manapparai,

Tondiarpet, Thuraiyur and Avinashi, Government issued several orders at an estimated cost of ₹182.30 Cr. and works are in progress.

Construction of Maternal and Child Health buildings at Government hospital Tindivanam, Tambaram, Srivilliputhur, Gobichettipalayam, Ambasamudram and Tenkasi at an estimated cost of ₹41.34 Cr. Of 6 works, 4 works are completed and 2 works are in progress.

Establishment of critical care block in Thanjavur, Tirunelveli, Chengalpattu, Sivaganga, Tiruvarur and Dharmapuri Government Medical College hospitals & Government hospitals at Cuddalore, Uthangarai, Melur, Oddanchattram and Sirkazhi at an estimated cost of ₹214.00 Cr. are in progress.

Establishment of sound proof rooms for 25 CEMONC centres in Government hospitals at an estimated cost of ₹ 3.00 Cr. has been completed. Construction of new buildings to Paediatric unit in Government Rajaji hospital, Madurai at an estimated cost of ₹20.00 Cr. is in progress.

Establishment of 50 bedded critical care block in Government Medical College hospital Otteri, Kilpauk, Kanniyakumari and Chidambaram at an estimated cost of ₹ 80.00 Cr. Of 4 works, 3 works are in progress and 1 work will be taken up shortly.

Establishment of 50 bedded critical care blocks in Government hospitals at Paramathi-Velur, Arakkonam, Sivakasi, Harur and Ulundurpet at an estimated cost of ₹ 100.00 Cr. has been taken up. Of the 5 works, 3 works are in progress and 2 will be taken up shortly.

Establishment of 100 bedded critical care block in Royapettah Government hospital at an estimated cost of ₹40.05 Cr. to be taken up.

Establishment of 8 District Integrated Public Health Laboratories in Government hospitals at Kovilpatti, Kancheepuram, Palacode, Gobichettipalayam, Sirkazhi, Mannargudi, Arakkonam and Coonoor at an estimated cost of ₹10.00 Cr. Of 8 works, 5 works are in progress and 3 works will be taken up shortly.

Construction of additional building in 16 Government hospitals in Thirukazhukundram, Bhuvanagiri, Pappireddipatti, Harur, Vedasandur, Sankarapuram, Anthiyur, Kulasekaram, Kuttalam, Peravoorani, Thandarampattu, Vempakkam, Villathikulam, Jallipatti, Gingee and Thirupuvanam at an estimated cost of ₹ 80.00 Cr. 10 works are in progress and 6 will be taken up shortly.

Construction of ladies hostel building for PG and UG students at Government Dental College hostel campus, Chennai at an estimated cost of ₹64.90 Cr. Work will be taken up shortly.

Construction of additional infrastructural facilities in Government Siddha Medical College hospital in Chennai at an estimated cost of ₹5.09 Cr. is in progress.

Construction of additional building to Government hospital at Sankarankoil, Tenkasi district at an estimated cost of ₹9.00 Cr. will be taken up shortly.

Upgradation of Government Cancer hospital in Balarengapuram in Madurai at an estimated cost of ₹4.61 Cr. is in progress.

Construction of new building for Maternal and Child Health hospital at Vijayapuram in Tiruvarur at an estimated cost of ₹6.00 Cr. is in progress.

Upgradation of pay wards in 7 Government Medical College hospitals at Tirunelveli, Kanniyakumari, Villupuram, Pudukottai, Dharmapuri, Thanjavur and Tirunelveli and 8 Government District Head Quarters hospitals are being taken up at an estimated cost of ₹12.00 Cr.

- Of 7 Government Medical College hospitals, 1 work completed and 6 works are in progress.
- Of 8 Government District Head Quarters hospitals at Pollachi, Cuddalore, Erode, Kanchipuram, Kumbakonam, Tenkasi, Kovilpatti and Perambalur, 1 work has been completed and 7 works are in progress.

Establishment of Multi-Speciality Dental centre in 4 Government Medical College hospitals at an estimated cost of ₹4.49 Cr. Of the 4 works, Madurai work completed, Coimbatore and Tirunelveli works are in progress and Salem work will be taken up shortly.

8.6.2. Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program

Construction of third, fourth and fifth floor at Government Arignar Anna Memorial Cancer Hospital, Karapettai, Kanchipuram at an estimated cost of ₹100.00 Cr. is in progress.

Construction of new tower block-II building in Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai at an estimated cost of ₹125.00 Cr. is in Progress.

Strengthening of Government Peripheral hospital, Periyar Nagar with construction of new building at an estimated cost of ₹55.07 Cr is in progress.

Construction of Neuro Block in Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai at an estimated cost of ₹60.00 Cr. is in progress.

Construction of hospital buildings at Uthiramerur, Tirupathur, Sattur, Vandavasi, Chengam, Palacode, Virudhachalam, Yercaud, Kalakad, Rajadhani, Uthamapalayam, Periyakulam and Thirumayam at an estimated cost of ₹45.18 Cr. 5 works completed and 8 works are in progress.

Construction of new Tamil Nadu Accident and Emergency Care Initiative (TAEI) building at

Government hospital at Chengam at an estimated cost of ₹3.50 Cr. is in progress.
