#### WELFARE OF THE DIFFERENTLY ABLED PERSONS

Tamil Nadu has been at the forefront in implementing various provisions of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995. The Government created a separate Directorate for Rehabilitation of the Disabled in the year 1993 to deal exclusively with the Welfare of the Differently Abled. Subsequently, the Directorate was upgraded as the office of the State Commissioner for the Disabled and a separate Department was also created at the Secretariat level, namely Department for Welfare of the Differently Abled Persons.

The Commissionerate is headed by the State Commissioner for the Differently Abled who is a Senior IAS officer. He is assisted by Joint Director and other officers in the Commissionerate and by the District Differently Abled Welfare Officers in the districts.

#### 2. MAINTENANCE ALLOWANCE TO THE SEVERELY AFFECTED DIFFERENTLY ABLED AND MENTALLY RETARDED PERSONS:

Aim of the Scheme The scheme provides Maintenance Allowance of Rs.1,500/- per month to severely affected differently abled persons with disability percentage of 75% and above who cannot be rehabilitated by any other means like education, training, assistance for self-employment, placement etc. It has been enhanced from Rs,1000/- to Rs1500/- per month from April 2014. The mentally retarded persons with a disability percentage of 45% and above are eligible for this benefit. The maintenance allowance is sent through ECS to the bank account of the individual directly from Treasury.

# 25. HOMES FOR THE MENTALLY RETARDED PERSONS ABOVE THE AGE OF 14 YEARS:

Aim of the Scheme

Homes for the mentally retarded were established through the Non Governmental Organisations in the seven Districts of Tiruvallur, Kancheepuram, Dindugal, Madurai, Coimbatore, Tirunelveli and Tiruchirapalli to benefit 40 Mentally Retarded Persons. During the year 2011-12, 10 Homes were started at Chennai, Cuddalore, Ramanathapuram, Salem, Sivagangai, Thanjavur, Namakkal, Erode, Thoothukudi and Kanyakumari for Men. The main Objectives of the Scheme is to provide shelter and support through Vocational Training Programmes to Mentally Retarded Persons above the age of 14 years. To provide shelter, food, medical facilities and rehabilitation services to the mentally ill persons, 32 Mentally ill Homes were established through voluntary organizations in all 32 Districts during 2014-2015. A maximum of 50 mentally ill persons are accommodated in each home.
