## DEPARTMENT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE DIFFERENTLY ABLED PERSONS PERFORMANCE BUDGET - 2020-2021

Tamil Nadu has been at the forefront in implementing various provisions of Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and full Participation) Act, 1995. The Government created a separate Directorate for Rehabilitation of the Disabled in the year 1993 to deal exclusively with the Welfare of the Differently Abled. Subsequently, the Directorate was upgraded as the office of the State Commissioner for the Differently Abled and a separate Department was created during the year 2010 at the Secretariat level, namely Department for Welfare of the Differently Abled Persons.

The Commissionerate is headed by the Commissioner for Welfare of the Differently Abled, who is an IAS officer. He is assisted by a Joint Director and other officers in the Commissionerate and by the District Differently Abled Welfare Officers in the Districts.

#### XXIV. UDID TRAINING (UNIQUE DISABILITY IDENTITY CARD)

Description of the Scheme:

The Government of India has launched the National Disability Database to store up Differently Abled Persons profile in the NIC cloud and make it available and accessible at any time.

The main objective of UDID project is to identify all differently abled persons to digitalize their details through UDID web portal for e-disability certificate and e-UDID card. The project will also help in stream-lining and the tracking of physical and financial progress of beneficiary at all levels of hierarchy of implementation – from village level, block level, District level, State level and National level.

Tamil Nadu is one among the 13 States chosen for launching of UDID Project. The State Government has released a sum of Rs.23.10 lakhs for conducting state and District level Training Programme under the Universal Disability Identity Card Project during the year 2016-2017, and training has been completed in all 32 districts.

#### XXV. NHFDC FUND

Description of the Scheme:

National Handicapped Finance Development Corporation (NHFDC) is providing assistance through various schemes, skill training programmes to differently abled persons for self empowerment and employment generation at concessional rate of interest. In order to augment the coverage of beneficiaries, the Government have issued orders to sanction interest free loan under NHFDC. (G.O.No.104/Cooperation, Food & Consumer Protection (CC1) Department, Dated: 26.03.2015)

During the Year 2016-17, a sum of Rs.17 Crore has been given to 3,355 beneficiaries under NHFDC.

During the year 2017-18, a sum of Rs.27.39 Crore has been given to 6,568 beneficiaries under NHFDC.

During the year 2018-19, a sum of Rs.31.73 Crore has been given to 6,947 beneficiaries under NHFDC.
