PRESS RELEASE

The Election Commission of India has announced the Special Summary Revision, 2020 with reference to 01.01.2020 as the qualifying date. The Election Commission of India with an objective to improve the health of electoral rolls and enrollment of all eligible citizens has introduced Electors Verification Programme (EVP) from 01.9.2019. The programme will be active till 15.10.2019. In this programme the citizens can verify and authenticate their electoral details through the following ways:-

- a. Voter Help Line 1950 (for Senior Citizens & PwDs only)
- b. Mobile App, (Voters help line)
- c. National Voters Service Portal (nvsp.in),
- d. By visiting Common Service Centres (CSC)
- e. By visiting Voters Facilitation Centres (VFC) at Electoral Registration Officer's Office

and authenticate their details relating thereto, by submitting a copy of one of the following documents:-

- a. Indian Passport
- b. Driving Licence
- c. Aadhaar Card
- d. Ration Card
- e. Identity Card-Government/Semi Government Officials
- f. Bank Pass Book
- g. PAN Card
- h. Farmers Identity Card
- i. Smart Card issued by Registrar General of India under National Population Register.
- j. Latest Water/Telephone/Electricity/Gas connection bill

So far 23,37,426 Electors have verified and authenticated their details under this Programme, which includes verification and authentication of 9,00,403 Electors through Voter Helpline Mobile APP, 19,341 electors through National Voters Service Portal and 12,85,839 electors through Voter Facilitation Centres.

The Electors are requested to avail this opportunity and verify their details in the Electoral Roll and authenticate through any one of the facilities mentioned above.
