With a view to clear the huge pendency of documents and enabling the Public to get back their registered documents quickly and also to realize the Government revenue blocked in these documents, a 'Samadhan Scheme' is being introduced in the Registration Department with effect from 3.1.2018.

According to the scheme, Public can get back their registered documents pending under section 47A by paying 2/3rd of the difference of stamp duty between the duty already paid and the duty that has to be paid as per the guideline value. Documents which are pending as on 8.6.2017 for determination of market value under section 47A and that are pending with the registering officers for referring under section 47A are eligible for the scheme. The difference of stamp duty shall be paid in the Sub-Registrar office itself and the scheme will be in operation for a period of three months from 3.1.2018.

Public, whose documents are pending under section 47A, are requested to avail this opportunity.
