During this COVID-19 Pandemic period, this Government under the leadership of Hon'ble Chief Minister has taken reduce austerity measures the administrative cost considerably, but pumping more money on development schemes such as Special Area Development Programme as

done. Hence, an amount of Rs.75 crore has been allocated for implementation of SADP for the year 2020-21.

For the year 2020-21, during XII SLEC, about 206 projects for a total cost of Rs.**86.78** crores (SADP Rs.85.53 Crores) were taken up for screening during the meeting. The Hon'ble Vice Chairman, SDPC suggested for close monitoring of the SADP Projects through both by the THIRD PARTY and by Technical team.

To the improve livelihood opportunity, the projects of INDCOSERVE (The Tamilnadu Small Tea Growers Industrial Cooperative Tea Factories Federation Ltd.) for 20 Food Trucks was approved along with Carbon Neutral Tea manufacturing by installing solar power plants which would address the climatic change issues. In addition to this, projects on Afforestation, Drinking Water were considered under this SLEC.

A 'Dashboard' exclusively for SADP has been developed and launched it is informed that the processing and appraisal of SADP proposals can be done through online process. **Web Monitoring System** has also been established for the effective and quick monitoring of the projects for Special Area Development Programme.
