Taking into account the fact that public examinations are being held in the State, the Collector of Dharmapuri had, in the all political parties' meeting conducted by her on 22.2.2010 informed them not to use cone speakers and vehicles fitted with public address system or loud speakers for public meetings / election campaigns in connection with the bye-election to Pennagaram Assembly Constituency within 100 mts. of examination centres.

It has been proposed to relocate 12 Polling Stations which are examination centres for which the Election Commission's approval has been sought.

Subsequently, the Collector has also issued instructions on 2<sup>nd</sup> March to the political parties to ensure that if loudspeakers are used for campaigning in or near habitations, the volume should be kept low so that there is no disturbance to the students preparing for the examinations.
