**PRESS RELEASE**

The Election Commission of India has announced Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls of Assembly Constituencies with reference to 01.01.2014 as the qualifying date with the following schedule:

Reading of relevant part/section of photo electoral rolls in Grama Sabha / Local Bodies and RWA meetings etc. & verification of names	02-10-2013 (Wednesday) and 05-10-2013 (Saturday)
Special Campaign dates with Booth Level Agents of political parties for receiving Claims and Objections	06-10-2013 (Sunday) 20-10-2013 (Sunday) 27-10-2013 (Sunday)
Final publication of Rolls	06-01-2014 (Monday)

All who are 18 years as on 01.01.2014 are eligible to submit applications for inclusion of their names in the electoral roll. Applications may also be filed for deletion, correction, and change in address within a constituency. (For change in address outside the constituency, a fresh application for inclusion needs to be filed)

The Electoral Photo Identity Cards for those whose names have been included would be given at functions to be held on the occasion of **National Voters Day** on 25<sup>th</sup> of January 2014 at the Polling Station locations.

As a run up to the Special Summary Revision, 2014 the rationalization of Polling Stations was carried out and completed. As result of the rationalization, the number of polling stations in Tamil Nadu has risen to 60418 from 58761. The details of Assembly Constituency wise polling stations have been hosted in the CEO's website [www.elections.tn.gov.in](http://www.elections.tn.gov.in).

A training was imparted to all the Booth Level Officers during the second fortnight of July, 2013 sensitizing them on the important issues relating to roll revision.

All the recognized Political Parties have been requested to appoint Booth Level Agents for the parts for which they have not been appointed. The Booth Level Agents will coordinate with the Booth Level Officers to find out the errors in the rolls for their rectification. The names of Booth Level Agents appointed by each Party will be hosted in the CEO's website after they are appointed.
