

Press Release

The final electoral rolls of Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls, 2017 are scheduled to be published on 05.01.2017.

The Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls with reference to 01.01.2017 as the qualifying date commenced with draft publication on 1st September 2016. Claims and objections were received from 01.09.2016 up to 30.09.2016.

During the above revision period, the following claims and objections have been filed and disposed:

qWAs per the final electoral rolls of Special Summary Revision, 2017, the total electorate in Tamil Nadu is 5.92 crores (Male – 2.93 crores ; Female – 2.99 crores and Third Gender - 5040). There is a net addition of 10.22 lakh electors in the final rolls of Special Summary Revision, 2017. Electors Photo Identity Cards for the new electors are being printed and will be delivered through the Booth Level Officers by 10th February, 2017.

Also, as per the final rolls, the Assembly Constituency with the highest number of electors is **27.Shozhinganallur** in Kancheepuram district with 6,22,333 electors. (Male: 3,12,816; Female: 3,09,443; Third Gender: 74). This Assembly Constituency has also the highest electors in the age group of 18-19 with 7935 electors. (Male: 4278 ; Female: 3657)

On the other hand, the lowest number of electors are in **164.Kilvelur (SC)** in Nagapattinam District with 1,66,920 electors (Male: 82,515; Female: 84,404; Third Gender 1).

196.Thirumangalam Assembly Constituency in Madurai district has the highest number of service electors with 2806 service electors.

624 overseas electors have also been enrolled.

The period of Continuous Revision is in operation now. Eligible persons not finding their names in the Electoral Rolls can apply for inclusion. Public are requested to apply online through the above mentioned website.
