The Government of Tamil Nadu in G.O.MS.No.16, Home (Transport III) Department, dated 7.1.2008 has published the Third Supplemental Reciprocal Agreement between the Government of Tamil Nadu and Karnataka on interstate transport of transport vehicles wherein it has ben reciprocally agreed to increase the quota of Counter-Signature of Permits to the Goods Vehicles of Tamil Nadu to Karnataka and vice versa from 7500 to 15000. Therefore, the State Transport Authority, Tamil Nadu has decided to issue 7500 fresh recommendation letters against these enhanced vacancies for issue of Counter-Signature of Permits to ply in Karnataka State on payment of Tax on Bilateral basis in respect of Tamil Nadu based Goods Carriages.

Those interested in obtaining such "Counter-Signature of Permits" to ply their Goods Carriages in Karnataka State on Bilateral-Tax basis, may apply to the Secretary, State Transport Authority, Ezhilagam, Chepauk, Chennai-5, in the prescribed form and manner together with the prescribed fee. <u>These</u> <u>vacancies will be allotted strictly on "First Come First Served Basis".</u> <u>Applications will be accepted subject to the availability of vacancies</u> <u>only</u>.
