**AN APPEAL TO THE TRAVELERS TOURING SRI LANKA COUNTRY
AGAINST AH1N1 INFLUENZA (Swine Flu)**

Since, AH1N1 Influenza cases are reported in Srilanka, travelers to Srilanka are requested to follow the guidelines given below:

1. Travelers to Srilanka are advised to get vaccinated against AH1N1 Influenza 2 - 3 weeks before the travel to Srilanka. Travelers are informed that vaccination against AH1N1 is available at the King Institute of Preventive Medicine, Guindy, Chennai on all days from 11.00 A.M. to 04.00 P.M.
2. In case one falls with flu like symptoms (Fever, cough, cold and sour throat) while traveling in Srilanka, they are requested to take treatment in Srilankan Govt. Hospitals.
3. On return from Srilanka, if any one develops flu like symptoms (Fever, cough, cold and sour throat) they are requested to contact the doctor for guidance and treatment.
