# Note on Livelihood Support Programme - TEAP

The ADB assisted TEAP aims at rehabilitating the tsunami affected at HLL, Thiruvanmiyur Kuppam, Semmancherri and the Marina Coastal Slums by adopting a special initiative and providing them with livelihood support. An Overall development through a package of service for the women, youth and children is aimed through participatory planning approach. The Government have sanctioned and released Rs.498.00 lakhs for the programme.

### **Project Components**

### I. Sub - Project Component

### 1. Formation of Self Help Groups

1120 Groups have been formed covering 14,925 Women / Men in HLL, Semmancherri, Thiruvanmiyur and Marina Coastal Slums. So far, Rs.3.78 lakhs has been paid to NGOs for the formation of 378 SHGs with 5609 Members.

# 2. Issue of Revolving fund

618 SHGs have been issued with Revolving Fund of Rs.30,000/- each at a total cost of Rs.185.40 lakhs benefiting 9742 Members (8917 Women + 825 Men).

# 3. Skill Training

Skill Training has been imparted to 362 members from 200 SHGs in various trades like Jute Making, Handcrafts Making, Shoe Upper Manufacture, Embroidery, Cosmetology, Sanitary Napkin, Fashion Design, Diploma in Graphics & Publishing, Zari and Zardosi work etc., for suitable alternative livelihood through either self employment or paid employment. The expenditure incurred under this components up to November was Rs.9.03 lakhs. 330 more youth are to be trained in trades like AC Refrigeration, Sales Person Training, Simple Chemicals, Computer Office Automation and Hand Embroidery at a total cost Rs.11.00 laks.

II. Livelihood Programme

#### 1. Smaller Economic Activities

Individual and SHG Members pursuing economic activity of small scale have been extended with TEAP grant not exceeding Rs.10,000/- so far 1229 persons from 659 SHGs have benefited at a total cost of Rs.49,04,739/-. Some of the activities for which economic assistance has been given include Sewing Machine, Wet Grinders, Mobile Bunks, Tricycle, Heavy Duty Sewing Machine, Push Cart, Beautician Kits, ICE Boxes for fishing retailing Rickshaws, Murrukku Machine, Garden Umbrella to fisher folks.

### 2. Major Livelihood Projects

### i. Livelihood Venture with eco friendly Auto

A Special initiative by Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board assisted 52 beneficiaries including 6 Women with the eco friendly three wheeler autos to restore / reconstruct their lost livelihood at a total cost of Rs.46,87,904/-.

### ii. Livelihood through Solid waste management

A Livelihood venture has been pursued through the management of Solid Waste by a federation of 20 SHG women. The bio-degradable waste generated will be transformed by vermin compost and organic compost (manure) which again will serve as a livelihood option.

### iii. Establishing a Community Developmental Stores

18 Women SHG Members were trained in Management of Community Departmental Store through TANSTIA FNF and assisted to setup a Store with allotment of 2 shops at Semmancherri and TEAP grant of Rs.50,000/-.

### iv. Provision of Three Wheeler Luggage Carrier

6 Fisher Men SHGs at Ernavoor were provided with 6 Three Wheeler Goods Carriers to transport fish, Vegetables and fruits from the market to their selling spot at a total cost of Rs.6,14,172/-.

Two Campaigns on health. Hygiene and sanitation were organized utilizing the IEC Materials in Semmancherri at South Chennai and Ernavoor at North Chennai at a total Cost of Rs.14,000/-.
