Appointment Orders for 57 candidates as Motor Vehicles Inspectors in Transport Department are issued by Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister Thiru. M.K.Stalin

Transport Department is indispensable for the social and economic growth of the State. Likewise the role of Motor Vehicles Inspectors assumes significance in issue of Driving Licenses, Registration of Vehicles, provision of transport facilities to the public, improvement of Road Safety measures and also to increase the Government revenue.

There are 1,32,20,752 vehicles as on date in Tamil Nadu. Transport Department yields revenue of Rs.2400 crore per year. For the past five years huge amount was provided to the improvement of infrastructure facilities in Transport Department. Forty three (43) new offices were created under the estimated cost of Rs.7.21 crore. Thirty nine (39) new office buildings were constructed under the estimated cost of Rs.35.82 crore and Seventeen (17) new Driving Test Tracks were formed under the estimated cost of Rs.4.90 crore. Moreover Road safety works were carried out to the expenditure of Rs.83.80 crore.

Taking into account of increase in vehicular strength and to strengthen the efficient administrative functions of the Department, the Government have created 243 new posts and recruited 330 new employees. At present 203 Motor Vehicles Inspectors are working in this Department against 333 total sanctioned posts. With a view to increase the efficiency in this Department, 47 Motor Vehicles Inspectors Gr.II were recruited in the last year. Today, appointment orders for 57 candidates as Motor Vehicles Inspectors Gr.II who were recruited through TNPSC, are issued by the Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister.

During this occasion, the Hon'ble Transport Minister Thiru.K.N.Nehru, Home Secretary Thiru.K.Gnanadesikan, I.A.S., Transport Commissioner Dr.M.Rajaram, IAS and other higher officials of Transport Department are also present.

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
