## PRESS RELEASE

April 2016 Examination for PG Degree/Diploma was conducted, according to the Medical Council Of India (MCI) norms for the candidates admitted from 2013-14 onwards. The same was communicated to all Deans/Principals of PG Medical Colleges affiliated to this University vide Lr.No.AC1(3)/21526/2013 dt 9.10.2013.

The MCI Norm Says...

- \* A candidate should obtain minimum 40 % marks in each theory paper and not less than 50 % marks cumulatively in all four papers for PG Degree Examination and Three paperss for Diploma examination .
- \* Candidates who are passed both in theory and clinical examination are declared as pass
- \* The valuation process was done for all the candidates according to the MCI norms. Second valuation has been done for the failed theory papers for the benefit of the students.
- \* In this April 2016, 1397 PG degree/Diploma candidates appeared. The result was published in the University website on 3.6.2016. PG Degree candidates appeared 941 passed 879 candidates (93.4%.) PG Diploma candidates appeared 456 passed 407 (89%).
- \* For the past three years also the passing percentage was same range of 90-95~%

\* Four years back the evaluation was done as component system but the studetns

challenged this in court. Therefore the Governing Council resolved to follow MCI

norms which is the regulatory body for medical courses.

\* However the representation of the failed candidates can be taken for consideration and

will be placed in the Governing Council (GC) of this University. The decision of the

GC will be sent to the MCI for further action.

\* The University will always stand for the students welfare and carrier.
