

POST – DOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP COURSE
IN MINIMAL ACCESS SURGERY
AT MADRAS MEDICAL COLLEGE, CHENNAI

The Minimal Access Surgery Department is functioning at Madras Medical College & Govt. General Hospital, Chennai and is doing Minimal Access Surgeries like Appendicectomy, Cholecystectomy, Adhesiolysis, Ovarian Cystectomy, Diagnostic Laparoscopy, Hernia Repair, Orchiopexy, Varicocelelectomy and Solid Organ Removal etc., and patients undergoing Minimal Access Surgery experience less pain, have shorter hospital stay, better wound results and return to work early.

Madras Medical College has been conducting Two-year Post-Doctoral Fellowship Course in Minimal Access Surgery, the first of its kind in a Govt. Medical College, since 2014 and the course is accredited to The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai.

Four candidates will be selected for the course for the year 2016 by appearing through an Entrance Examination. Among the four candidates two will be from service category and the other two will be from non service category.
