The State Planning Commission was constituted in Tamil Nadu on 25th May, 1971. The State Planning Commission functions under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Chief Minister. It functions as an advisory body and makes its recommendations to the Government on various matters pertaining to the development of the State.

Thiru.C.Ponnaiyan has been appointed as the Vice Chairman, State Planning Commission vide G.O.Ms.No.13, Planning, Development and Special initiatives (SPC) Department, dated: 09.03.2020 and he has assumed office today (12.3.2020) in the presence of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu and Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu. As per G.O.Ms.No.15, Planning, Development and Special initiatives (SPC) Department, dated: 12.03.2020, **he will have the status of a Minister of Tamil Nadu.**

The Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Planning, Development and Special Initiatives Department and the Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Finance Department are ex-officio Members of the Commission. The Member Secretary, State Planning Commission is in-charge of the administration of the Commission. The State Planning Commission functions under the administrative control of Planning, Development & Special Initiatives Department.
