

PRESS RELEASE

The Election Commission of India has directed the youth to file their advance applications with reference to three subsequent qualifying dates i.e. 01st April, 01st July and 01st October and not just 01st January. Henceforth, the Electoral Roll will be updated every quarter and eligible youngsters can be registered in the next quarter of the year in which he/she has attained the qualifying age of 18 years. After getting enrolled, he/she will be issued an Electoral Photo Identity Card (EPIC).

2. The electoral roll of Continuous Updation, 2023 (Quarter 3) with reference to 01.07.2023 as the qualifying date has been published on 10.07.2023. During the above Continuous Updation, 2023 (Quarter 3), 1,39,108 persons names were included as new electors and 27,332 Voters have changed their address from one place to another place. 3,42,185 deletions have been made on account of shifting, death and duplicate entries. Correction of entries have been done in respect of 1,04,141 electors.

3. As per the electoral roll of Continuous Updation, 2023 (Quarter 3) the total electorate in Tamil Nadu is 6,10,39,316 (Male – 3,00,29,237, Female – 3,10,02,098 and Third Gender – 7,981).

4. The electoral roll in the PDF format are available on CEO's website <https://elections.tn.gov.in/> Electors can check their names by visiting the same.

5. As per the directions of the Election Commission of India, the House to House verification by the Booth Level Officers will be commencing from 21.07.2023 for verification of the electors.
