PRESS RELEASE

The final electoral rolls of Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls, 2020 with reference to 01.01.2020 as the qualifying date have been published today (14.02.2020).

- 2. The Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls, 2020 with reference to 01.01.2020 as the qualifying date commenced with draft publication on 23.12.2019. Claims and objections were received during the period from 23.12.2019 to 22.01.2020.
- 3. During the above revision period, 14,65,890 applications for inclusion of names were received and 14,02,464 applications were admitted and names were included. Of the 1,18,681 applications for deletions which were received, 97,155 deletions have been made on account of shifting, death and duplicate entries.
- 4. 1,78,409 applications were received for correction of entries. Out of that 1,22,817 applications were admitted. In respect of transposition of entries within the Assembly Constituency, 1,14,790 applications were received and 90,943 have been admitted.
- 5. As per the final electoral rolls of Special Summary Revision, 2020 the total electorate in Tamil Nadu is 6,13,06,638 (Male 3,02,54,172; Female 3,10,45,969 and Third Gender 6,497).
- 6. Also, as per the final rolls, the Assembly Constituency with the highest number of electors is 27-Shozhinganallur Assembly Constituency with 6,60,317 electors (Male: 3,31,996; Female: 3,28,232; Third Gender: 89).
- 7. On the other hand, the lowest number of electors are in 18.Harbour Assembly Constituency with 1,73,337 electors (Male: 90,333; Female: 82,952; Third Gender: 52).
- 8. 16 overseas electors have also been enrolled during Special Summary Revision, 2020.
- 9. During the above revision period 5,85,580 electors in the age group of 18-19 have been enrolled (Male: 3,22,167; Female:2,63,213; Third Gender: 200)

- 10. The electoral rolls are available on CEO's website http://elections.tn.gov.in. Electors can check their names by visiting the same.
- 11. The period of Continuous Updation is in operation now. All eligible persons who have completed 18 years as on 01.01.2020 and not enrolled in the Electoral Rolls can apply in the following ways:-
 - I. By visiting the respective offices of the Electoral Registration
 Officers and submitting Form 6 or
 - II. By applying online through www.nvsp.in.
 - III. Through 'Voter Helpline App" available in google play store.
- 12. As per the directions of the Election Commission of India, District Contact Centres have been established covering all the districts of Tamil Nadu. The District Contact Centres have been provided with the toll free help line number 1950 uniformly across the State. For any election related queries, the public can call the District Contact Centre. The State Contact Centre is functioning in the office of the Chief Electoral Officer with the toll free number 180042521950.
