**PRESS RELEASE**

National Electoral Roll Purification and Authentication Programme (NERPAP) launched on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2015 as per the direction of the Election Commission of India with the objective of bringing a totally error-free and authenticated electoral roll is being implemented in a very successful manner in Tamil Nadu.

2. So far, 16.40 lakhs applications have been received for inclusion/deletion/correction/transposition of entries in the Electoral Rolls during the NERPAP period which are being disposed. As part of the electoral roll purification exercise, all the District Election Officers have been directed that field verification should be conducted for the Absent/Shifted/Dead cases and multiple entry cases and those cases which are found fit for deletion should be disposed of by 15.07.2015, following the due procedure.

2. The District Election Officers have been directed that lists of the Absent/Shifted/Dead cases and deletions arising out of de-duplication of multiple entries should be prepared and displayed on the Notice Boards of the AERO/ERO office by **18.07.2015**. A combined list of all the Absent/Shifted/Dead/Multiple Entry deletions of all the Assembly Constituencies comprised in the district will be displayed at the office of the District Election Officer for verification by the electors. The lists would be furnished to all the recognised political parties in the form of soft copy (CD) and would be hosted in the CEO's website: [elections.tn.gov.in](http://elections.tn.gov.in).
