ORDER:

- 1. As per the Government Order in the reference 1st cited, the working hours of the TASMAC Retail Vending liquor shops and the Bars attached thereto had been reduced from 24.5.2016. The working hours now is 12.00 Noon to 10.00 p.m. every day, as against the previous working hours of 10.00 a.m. to 10.00 p.m.
- 2. It has been further stated in the Government Order that the number of TASMAC retail vending liquor shops would be reduced and 500 (five hundred) TASMAC retail vending (RV) liquor shops would be closed after identifying suitable shops.

- 3. In the reference 2nd cited, the Commissioner of Prohibition and Excise had requested the MD, TASMAC to take follow up action early on the G.O. cited in the reference above.
- 4. The recommendations of the District Collectors, Senior Regional Managers, TASMAC and relevant details submitted by the District Managers (DM), TASMAC were taken into consideration while arriving at the list of 500 shops which are to be closed.
- 5. The list of retail vending liquor shops which have to be closed with effect from 19.6.2016 are listed out in Annexure to this order.
- 6. A separate order will be issued for the redeployment of employees working in these shops which are to be closed.
- 7. While closing the shops, the stocks have to be transferred back to the godowns. Properties other than the stock such as furniture, cash chest box, all records relating to the shops, billing machines, bottle coolers and other fixed assets etc., are to be handed over to the concerned District Manager. This has to be verified with the Asset Registers in the DM Office.
- 8. In some of the RV shops, advance rental has been paid to the building owner. In such cases, the respective District

Manager has to adjust/collect the rental advance from the building owner immediately as per the rules with proper acknowledgement.

9. While closing the shops, a certificate from the Internal Auditor should be obtained after the 100% physical verification of the RV shops being closed.

All the officers are directed to adhere to the above instructions scrupulously without any deviation. They should send a detailed report in complete shape on the action taken based on the above instructions.

The District Collectors are requested to ensure that the above instructions are implemented without any deviation.
