Every year 24th October is being observed as United Nation's Day

in World over. Government of India, the Ministry of Home Affairs has

instructed the State Governments to observe UN Day in India and to hoist UN

Flag along with the Indian National Flag on all buildings on which the National

Flag is regularly flown in the States The United Nation's Flag is, however not

flown on Raj Bhawan, Legislative Assembly and High Court. "when the United

Nation's Flag is flown along with the National Flag, it can be displayed on either

side of the National Flag. The general practice is to fly the National Flag on the

extreme right with reference to the direction which it is facing (ie., extreme left of

an observer facing the masts flying the flags"

In this regard, All District Collectors were also requested by the

Government of Tamil Nadu to observe 'United Nation's Day' on 24th October,

2008 in all the District Head Quarters in a fitting manner with the request that

the occasion may be utilised to inform the people about the aims and

achievements of the United Nations Organisations and to gain public support for

its work.
