## Meeting of Hon'ble Chief Minister with Mr. Richard. R. Verma Ambassador of USA to India

Ambassador of the United States of America India, to called Mr. Richard Verma on the Hon'ble Chief Thiru O. Panneerselvam today (19.02.2015) at the Secretariat. Ambassador was accompanied by Mr. Phillip A. Min, Consul General of the United States of America in Chennai.
