

**PRESS RELEASE**

The final electoral rolls of Special Summary Revision of Photo Electoral Rolls, 2021 with reference to 01.01.2021 as the qualifying date have been published today (20.01.2021).

2. The Special Summary Revision of Photo Electoral Rolls, 2021 with reference to 01.01.2021 as the qualifying date commenced with draft publication on 16.11.2020. Claims and objections were received during the period from 16.11.2020 to 15.12.2020.

3. During the above revision period, 21,82,120 applications for inclusion of names were received and 21,39,395 applications were admitted and names included. 5,09,307 deletions have been made on account of shifting, death and duplicate entries.

4. 3,32,743 applications were received for correction of entries and 3,09,292 were admitted. For transposition of entries within the Assembly Constituency, 1,84,791 applications were received and 1,75,365 have been admitted.

5. As per the final electoral rolls of Special Summary Revision, 2021 the total electorate in Tamil Nadu is 6,26,74,446 (Male – 3,08,38,473 ; Female – 3,18,28,727 and Third Gender – 7,246).

6. Also, as per the final rolls, the Assembly Constituency with the highest number of electors is 27-Shozhinganallur Assembly Constituency in Chengalpattu district with 6,94,845 electors (Male: 3,48,262; Female: 3,46,476; Third Gender: 107).

7. On the other hand, the lowest number of electors are in 18.Harbour Assembly Constituency in Chennai District with 1,76,272 electors (Male: 91,936; Female: 84,281; Third Gender: 55).

8. 47 overseas electors have also been enrolled during Special Summary Revision 2021.

9. So far 4,62,597 nos. of PwD electors have been flagged in the electoral rolls.

10. During the above revision period 8,97,694 electors in the age group of 18-19 have been enrolled (Male:4,80,953 ; Female : 4,16,423 and Third Gender :318)

11. The electoral rolls are available on CEO's website <http://elections.tn.gov.in>. Electors can check their names by visiting the same.

12. The period of Continuous Updation is in operation now. All eligible persons who have completed 18 years as on 01.01.2021 and who do not find their names in the Electoral Rolls can apply in the following ways

- I. By visiting the respective offices of the Electoral Registration Officers and submitting Form – 6
- II. By applying online through **www.nvsp.in**.
- III. Through ‘Voter Helpline App’ available in google play store.

13. As per the directions of the Election Commission of India, District Contact Centers have been established in all the districts of Tamil Nadu. The District Contact Centers have been provided with the toll free help line number 1950 uniformly across the State. For any election related queries, the public can call the District Contact Center. The State Contact Center is functioning in the office of the Chief Electoral Officer with the toll free number 180042521950.
