

PRESS NOTE**I. INAUGURATION OF DGP OFFICE ANNEXE BUILDING :**

The Director General of Police office, known in popular parlance as the office of Inspector General of Police has been functioning in an heritage structure facing Marina Beach at Kamarajar Salai, Mylapore, Chennai in an area spread over 11.739 acres. Since the existing structure was found highly inadequate to accommodate the present strength, it was proposed to construct a new building at Tharamani. This proposal was dropped and the Government ordered construction of an Annexe building adjacent to the present Director General of Police office with an elevation fully in consonance with the existing structure.

The Government accorded administrative and financial sanction in G.O.Ms.No.267, Home (Pol X) Dept. dated 16.02.2007 for construction of the Annexe with an area of 1,71,600 Sq.ft. Revised administrative and financial sanction was accorded in G.O.Ms.No. 1568, Home (Pol X) Dept. dated 20.11.2008 to construct in a built up area of 1,61,702 Sq.ft at a cost of Rs.24.50 crores. The Annexe building consists of three blocks with A Block designed for G+1 floor and the other two with G+2 floors.

The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu laid foundation stone for construction of the Annexe building on 30.07.2008. Now, as per Government instructions, this Annexe building has been constructed fully in consonance with the existing heritage structure, especially elevation, but at the same time providing for modern amenities.

The following amenities are available in the new structure:

- I. Conference Hall, Multi-purpose Hall, Staff Section, Stores etc.
- II. Two / four – wheeler parking at the basement.
- III. Drivers Room, Dispensary, Record Room, Barracks for TSP Battalion, Canteen facilities etc.
- IV. Two Lifts, fire protection system, DG set, lightning arrestors have been provided.
- V. Intercom facilities, cubical work station, public address system, CCTV, Roofing with poly carbonate for OTS area have also been provided.
- VI. Granite flooring laid for "A" Block, Verandah, Conference Hall and Multi-purpose Hall. In all other places Wooden, Porcellor, Ceramic and Sahabad flooring have been laid.
- VII. Air conditioning has been provided for Officer's Chamber, Conference Hall, Multi-purpose Hall etc.
- VIII. Aside from providing requisite sanitary facilities and lighting arrangements, a 250 KVA generator has also been made available for the new structure.

II. NOTES ON THE CONSTRUCTION OF SB-CID OFFICE BUILDING AT MARUTHAM COMPLEX, CHENNAI CITY:

The Government have accorded approval for the construction of Training centre and Barracks for Women Commandos at Marutham Complex at an estimated cost of Rs.144/- lakhs vide in the G.O.Ms.No.750 Home (Modern) Department, dated 12.12.2006.

It was constructed two blocks (i) Multi-purpose Hall at Marutham Complex and (ii) Officers – ADGP/IGP/SP – block at Marutham Campus.

The date on which work for the Multi-purpose Hall commenced was 31.08.2007.

The work was completed in all respects and handed over on 31.10.2008. The building was occupied by the Special Security, SB-CID (Multi-purpose Hall) as per the Proceedings of the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu in C.No.122707 / Buildings II (3) / DGP TN / Camp / 08, dated 07.07.2008.

The plinth area of the SB-CID Office is 715.40 Sq.m. (or) 7697.70 Sq.ft. and the total cost on completion of the building stood at Rs.88.44 lakhs. The flooring has been finished with vitrified tiles, the toilet flooring finished with ceramic tiles and wall embedded with glazed tiles. Necessary compound has also been put in place.

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
