Restoration of Flood damaged roads by Highways Department

(Status as on 22.12.2015)

1. Based on the instructions given in the State level meeting held on

17.12.2015 by the Hon'ble Minister for Highways and Minor Ports and

the Principal Secretary with all officials (Chief Engineers, Superintending

Engineers and Divisional Engineers), the urgent temporary flood

restoration works were identified for funds allocation under State

Disaster Relief Fund (SDRF) sanction of Rs.150 Crore covering

38 Divisions.

2. Utilising the funds provided under SDRF, Repairs/Reconstruction of 150

bridges/culverts/ causeways are being taken up at a cost of

Rs.13 Crore. In the 54 breached roads, it has been proposed to provide

Cross drainage works at a cost of Rs.5.92 Crore.

3. Restoration of landslide sites with construction of necessary permanent

retaining walls are being taken up at a cost of Rs. 1.90 crore at 119

locations.

4. Filling up of pot holes and patch work for restoration of riding surface

with bituminous concrete material and repairing of berms have been

taken up in the 2667 Km stretch of damaged roads at a cost of

Rs. 129.17 Crore.

5. It is programmed to complete all road repair works before 31.01.2016

and construction of the 7 lengthy causeways before 29.02.2016 on war

footing basis.
