## PRESS RELEASE

The Election Commission of India has announced Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls with reference to 01.01.2020 as the qualifying date.

- 2. The draft rolls have been published on 23.12.2019 (today) in all the districts in the Designated Locations (mostly polling station locations which are school buildings). The rolls are also hosted on the website: <u>elections.tn.gov.in</u> Copies of the Rolls will be handed over to the Recognized Political Parties by the District Election Officers.
- 3. As per the draft electoral rolls of Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls of 2020, published today, the total electorate in Tamil Nadu is 6,00,01,329 (Male: 2,96,46,287, Female: 3,03,49,118, Third Gender: 5,924).
- 4. The highest electorate in the State is in 27. Sholinganallur Assembly Constituency with 6,46,073 electors (Male: 3,25,028, Female: 3,20,963, Third Gender: 82).
- 5. 18. Harbour Assembly Constituency has the lowest electorate in the State with 1,69,620 electors (Male: 88,483, Female: 81,087, Third Gender 50).
- 6. The Special Campaigns will be conducted on 04.01.2020, 05.01.2020, 11.01.2020 and 12.01.2020 which are Saturdays and Sundays at the Designated Locations (generally the polling stations). Forms for inclusion/ deletion/ modification/transposition of entries in the Electoral

Rolls will be available at the Designated Locations. Filled in forms can be submitted there.

- 7. During the claims and objection period i.e. from 23.12.2019 to 22.01.2020 of Special Summary Revision, 2020 an elector or an eligible citizen who wants to get enrolled or wants to make deletion/correction/transposition in existing entry may submit form 6, 7, 8 or 8A to:
  - (1) Booth Level Officer or Electoral Registration Officer / Assistant Electoral Registration Officers office on any working day;
  - (2) Booth Level Officers on Special Camp days at the respective polling stations;
  - (3) the Designated Officer at the designated location on any working day during the Summary Revision claims and objections period.
- 8. For inclusion, proof of address and age should be submitted along with the Form. For proof of residence copy of any one of the following documents viz., Passport/Driving License/Aadhaar Card/Ration Card/Identity Card-Government/Semi-Government Officials/Bank Pass Book/PAN Card/Farmer Identity Card/Smart Card issued by RGI under NPR/ Latest Water/Telephone/Electricity/Gas connection bill may be submitted. Copy of Birth Certificate or School Leaving Certificate may be Proof of age is compulsory for applicants below submitted as proof of age. Online filing is also possible by going to the website 25 years of age. www.nvsp.in and VOTER HELP LINE mobile app.
- 9. Persons who will be completing 18 years of age on 01.01.2020 and the persons whose names are not included in the Electoral Rolls can apply for inclusion. Applicants should compulsorily fill in the 'Declaration' column of Forms submitted by them.

10. If the name of the elector is already in Roll, but he/she has lost/misplaced the EPIC, then he/she may apply any time in the Taluk

Office/ Zonal Office in Form 001.

11. For inclusion of Indian citizens living abroad, Form 6A should

be submitted directly to the Electoral Registration Officer concerned or sent

by post to the Electoral Registration Officer. If Form 6A is submitted in

person before the ERO, the application should be accompanied by a photo

copy of the relevant pages of the passport containing the photograph and

all other particulars of the applicant and the page containing the valid visa

endorsement. The original passport will be verified by the ERO and

returned immediately after verification. If the Form 6A is sent by post,

it should be accompanied by a photocopy of the passport duly self-attested.
