I would like to bring to your kind notice that there are 559 Tablighis from Tamil Nadu, who had attended Tabligh Jamaat in New Delhi. They have been hospitalised or quarantined, as detailed below:-

State Government has been receiving a number of grievances with regard to conditions of their stay. The individuals have been complaining that some of them are diabetic and suffering from other co-morbidities. They are also not provided timely meals in the quarantine facilities. One Thiru. Muhammed Mustafa Hajiyar who was in quarantine expired on 22.4.2020 morning.

Whenever grievances are received from quarantined / hospitalised individuals, the Principal Resident Commissioner (Mobile No.9810254777) Tamil Nadu House, New Delhi has been taking up the same with the Health and Family Welfare Department, Delhi or the District Magistrates concerned, requesting necessary action to redress their grievances.

Hence, I request you to instruct the authorities concerned to extend the best possible care for the quarantined / hospitalised individuals and also provide necessary medical assistance to those who are suffering from co-morbid conditions. As the Ramadan month is due to start, authorities may be asked to provide food and medicine to them at appropriate times.
