TAMIL NADU VETERINARY AND ANIMAL SCIENCES UNIVERSITY

Counseling for admission to BVSc & AH degree course for the academic year 2018-19 was conducted by the Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University on 25.07.2018 at Madras Veterinary College, Chennai 600 007.

For the 306 seats available in Veterinary Colleges located in Chennai, Namakkal, Orathanadu and Tirunelveli, 12107 applications were received. Among them, 10289 applicants were found eligible. Special Categories and Vocational Stream seats were filled yesterday and remaining 269 seats are filled in today's counseling. Counseling call letters have been sent to 824 candidates who studied HSC under Academic Stream for today's counseling. Of these, 466 candidates attended the counseling:

Employment opportunities to veterinary graduates are many. Veterinarians have better scopes for employment in State and Central government departments like Animal Husbandry, Army, Aavin, private dairy sector, Meat Corporations, Livestock feed industries, Pharmaceuticals, banking and insurance sector, Livestock and Poultry farms, Zoological parks and Diagnostic laboratories. They can also pursue post graduation to enter academic field or can become entrepreneurs by starting their own farm enterprises. They can also get into administrative services. Due to commercialization of veterinary industry and economic liberalization policies, more and more international industries dealing with food manufacturing, pharmaceutical, diagnostic and vaccine production etc have opened up more opportunities for employment of veterinary graduates.
