

**PRESS RELEASE**

National Electoral Roll Purification and Authentication Programme (NERPAP) launched on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2015 as per the direction of the Election Commission of India is being implemented in a very successful manner. So far 2 Special Camps for NERPAP have been conducted. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> Special Camp conducted on 26<sup>th</sup> April 2015, total 20 lakhs number of electors participated and have furnished their Aadhaar details along with the contact information and have verified the correctness of their information in the electoral roll and 4 lakh numbers of claims have been received in this Special Camp day. Out of 5.62 Crores electors in Tamil Nadu, details of about 3.5 Crores electors have been collected under NERPAP which is about 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of the total electors in the State. Feeding of data is simultaneously being done in a very systematic manner and so far 2.17 Crores electors' data have been computerized in the computer which is about 40% of total electors of Tamil Nadu. The 3<sup>rd</sup> Special Camp would be conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> of May 2015. An appeal is made to the electors who have yet to give their particulars of Aadhaar and contact address and have yet to verify the correctness of their details in the Electoral Roll may come forward and share this information with the Booth Level Officers (BLOs) or through Internet ([www.nvsp.in](http://www.nvsp.in)) and [tnvoteraadhaar@gmail.com](mailto:tnvoteraadhaar@gmail.com), SMS (166/51969) and telephonic call (1950) so that the objectives of this Special programme of Election Commission of India may be obtained in full, since NERPAP aims at establishing a continuous link between the Election Commission of India and the individual Electors.
