2. During the claims and objection period i.e. from 17.10.2023 to 30.11.2023 of Special Summary Revision of Photo Electoral Roll, 2024 an elector or an eligible citizen who wants to get enrolled or wants to make deletion/correction/ linking of Aadhar with EPIC/ transposition in existing entry may submit form 6, 6B, 7 or 8 to the:

- (1) Booth Level Officer or Electoral Registration Officer / Assistant Electoral Registration Officers office on any working day;
- (2) Booth Level Officers on Special Camp days at the respective polling stations;
- (3) The Designated Officer at the designated location on any working day during the Summary Revision claims and objections period.

3. For inclusion, proof of address and age should be submitted along with the Form. For proof of residence, copy of any one of the following documents to be attached:-

- i. Water/ Electricity/ Gas Connection Bill for that address (atleast 1 year)
- ii. Aadhaar Card
- iii. Current passbook of National / Scheduled Bank / Post Office
- iv. Indian Passport
- v. Revenue Department's Land Owning Records including Kisan Bahi
- vi. Registered Rent Lease Deed (in case of tenant)
- vii. Registered Sale Deed (in Case of own house)

For proof of age, self-attested copy of any one of the following documents to be attached:-

- i. Birth Certificate issued by Competent Local Body/ Municipal Authority/ Registrar of Births & Deaths.
- ii. Aadhaar Card
- iii. PAN Card
- iv. Driving License
- v. Certificates of Class X or Class XII issued by CBSE/ICSE/State Education Boards, if it contains Date of Birth
- vi. Indian Passport

Proof of age is compulsory for applicants below 25 years of age. Online filing is also possible by going to the websites <u>www.voters.eci.gov.in</u>, <u>https://voterportal.eci.gov.in</u> and VOTER HELP LINE mobile app.

4. Persons who will be completing 18 years of age on 01.01.2024, 01.04.2024, 01.07.2024 and 01.10.2024 and the persons whose names are not included in the Electoral Rolls can apply for inclusion in Form-6. Applicants should compulsorily fill in the 'Declaration' column of Forms submitted by them. For quality improvement of the electoral roll, the applicants have been advised to paste/upload colour photograph of 200 dpi resolution.

5. For inclusion of Indian citizens living abroad, Form 6A should be submitted directly to the Electoral Registration Officer concerned or sent by post to the Electoral Registration Officer. If Form 6A is submitted in person before the ERO, the application should be accompanied by a photo copy of the relevant pages of the passport containing the photograph and all other particulars of the applicant and the page containing the valid visa endorsement. The original passport will be verified

by the ERO and returned immediately after verification. If the Form 6A is sent by post, it should be accompanied by a photocopy of the passport duly self-attested.

6. An elector can apply in Form 6B to link Aadhar number to his/her EPIC. If a person shifts his place of ordinary residence within the same constituency/ outside the constituency in which he/she is already registered as an elector or correction of particulars of a person entered in the electoral roll or for getting replacement EPIC on shifting/ correction/ loss/ mutilated/ destructed, he/she should apply in Form 8.
