Building on this momentum, today's launch includes Parts of Speech & Semantic Role Labelling, Speech-to-Text for Dialects, and Hyphenation Support for Tamil Typesetting. The remaining three software tools are currently in the final stages of development.

These software are designed for ease of use across various user groups. A brief overview of each software tool is given below.

- 1. 1.**Tamil Text Editor**: It is an advanced software tool designed to revolutionize Tamil language studies by compiling comprehensive indexes and concordances. This software is poised to become an indispensable resource for students, scholars, and researchers.
- 2. **Chatbot for TVA's Lessons**: An innovative chatbot designed to enhance the learning experience for students enrolled in our Certificate, Diploma and

Degree courses. This tool is set to introduce interactive elements in the way students access TVA's lessons.

- 3. Inscription Reader: A cutting-edge software designed to convert ancient inscriptions dating from the 6th to the 10th century found across the Kanchipuram & Chengalpattu districts into contemporary Tamil has been developed. This innovative tool is a significant step forward in preserving and understanding the rich history of Tamil language and culture.
- 4. **Tamil Learning App**: An innovative learning application has been designed to make Tamil language acquisition engaging and enjoyable for new learners to learn three tenses of verbs.
- 5. Parts of Speech & Semantic Role of Labelling: A groundbreaking software has been designed to provide comprehensive grammar references for Tamil sentences and analyze semantic roles within them.
- 6. Speech to Texts Dialects: An innovative software accurately converts spoken Tamil into written text in real-time. It is capable of recognizing and processing a wide range of Tamil dialects, including those from the North, South, East, West of Tamil Nadu. As the speech is delivered, the software dynamically transcribes it into text displayed on the screen.
- 7. **Hyphenation Support for Tamil Typesetting**: This software automatically splits Tamil words into proper syllables, ensuring that paragraphs are perfectly aligned and formatted. It offers a significant advancement in typesetting capabilities.

Additionally, the book 'Thamizhai Pizhaiyinri Ezhuthuvom' was released to assist in writing Tamil accurately without grammatical errors and spelling mistakes. This comprehensive guide simplifies the fundamentals of Tamil letters, words, and phrases, covering various linguistic topics such as word segmentation, word combination rules, Sandhi rules, and language style. The book was officially launched by the Honourable Minister and was received by the Additional Chief Secretary of the Department of Information Technology and Digital Services.
