SCHEME FOR FARMERS

“Artificial Recharge to Ground Water through Dug Wells”

The scheme involves installation of recharge structures in the existing irrigation open wells of the beneficiary farmers in the affected areas to facilitate ground water recharge. The scheme is implemented by Government of Tamilnadu funded by Government of India.

Till date, an amount of Rs. 126.00 Crore covering 3,38,002 well owners was disbursed. 20,747 farmers are benefited by constructing Artificial Recharge structures. Particularly a farmer of Morapur block of Dharmapuri district states that the water level of his well has raised to 7 feet after construction of Artificial Recharge Structures.
