## **Press Release**

The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has announced the launch of a new initiative titled "Reaching Your Roots". This scheme aims to strengthen the bond between the Tamil diaspora and their ancestral culture and heritage. Under this program, every year, 200 students from the Tamil diaspora community will be given the opportunity to embark on a cultural tour of Tamil Nadu.

As part of the inaugural batch, 57 students were selected from Australia, Fiji, Sri Lanka, and Canada. These students experienced a 15-day tour from December 27, 2023, to January 10, 2024. The Commissionerate organized visits to various historical and cultural destinations across Tamil Nadu, providing participants with a deep understanding of the region's rich art and cultural heritage.

The second batch of this program is scheduled for August 1, 2024, to August 15, 2024. As of June 28, 2024, 107 students from 11 countries – South Africa, Uganda, Fiji, Indonesia, Mauritius, Australia, Maldives, Canada, Myanmar, Malaysia, and Sri Lanka – have registered their interest in participating in the program.

This initiative is a testament to Tamil Nadu's commitment to fostering a strong connection with the global Tamil community and ensuring that the younger generation remains connected to their roots.
