- iii. To provide rights to Scheduled Tribes and other traditional Forest Dwellers on land used for community purposes.

The panel discussion topics were presented by the Director, Tribal Welfare, District Collectors of The Nilgiris, Coimbatore, Kallakurichi and Tirunelveli.
