2. In the meeting, the political parties will be informed about the disposal of forms during Special Summary Revision of Photo Electoral Rolls and also about the schedule for Special Summary Revision, 2022.

3. The Election Commission of India has announced the following schedule for the conduct of Special Summary Revision, 2022:-

4. As per the ECI instructions, the recognized political parties can appoint Booth Level Agents (BLAs) for each polling station. The Booth Level Agents can assist the Booth Level Officers (BLOs) in identifying corrections, etc. during Special Summary Revision, 2022 and also in Special campaign days. Booth Level Agents can list out the dead and shifted electors and present the list to the Booth Level Officers in the formats prescribed by the Election Commission of India.

5. In this regard, brief power point on various activities and schedules for Special Summary Revison, 2022 will be presented during the meeting with the representatives of Political parties. The suggestions and views from the representatives of Political parties will also be considered during the meeting.
