

Press Release

The Pensioners and Family Pensioners of the Government of Tamil Nadu who are drawing pension from the Pension Pay Office, Chennai and District / Sub Treasuries have to appear in person at the concerned Treasuries / Pension Pay Office for mustering every year from 1st April to 30th June. Pensioners / Family Pensioners who are unable to come in person can send the Life Certificate to the concerned Treasuries / Pension Pay Office, Chennai. For the year 2019, all the Pensioners / Family Pensioners are requested to approach the concerned Treasuries / Pension Pay Office, Chennai for mustering between April-2019 and June-2019 on government working days. And also it is informed that the Pensioner / Family Pensioner who already attended the mustering process for this year no need to come again.

The Pensioners / Family Pensioners can approach their nearest **e-Sevai Centre** of Tamil Nadu Arasu Cable TV Corporation for generating the digital life certificate through 'Jeevan Pramaan' Portal using Aadhaar authentication without appearing in person at the concerned Treasuries / Pension Pay Office, Chennai.

I. Pensioners appearing in person

The pensioners appearing in person for mustering are requested to bring Pension Book without fail. Pensioners / Family Pensioners who have not submitted the PAN Card, Ration Card, Core Banking account number details are requested to produce the same at the concerned Treasuries by marking the PPO number in the Xerox copies. If they have Aadhaar Card, it shall be produced at Treasuries for attaching the same to generate digital life certificate through 'Jeevan Pramaan'.

II Pensioners unable to appearing in person

A) Pensioners who are unable to appear in person can send the life certificate along with a copy of the Pension Pay Order. Pensioners who have not submitted the Aadhaar number, Ration Card, Core Banking account number can send copy of the above documents along with life certificate in the prescribed form to the Treasuries / Pension Pay Office, Chennai concerned. The life certificate form can be downloaded from (www.tn.gov.in/Karuvoolam/). The life certificate form should be attested by any one of the following officials.

- Bank Branch manager, the pensioner having SB account (or)
- Gazetted Officers of State / Central Government (or)
- Tahsildar / Deputy Tahsildar / Revenue Inspector

The Pensioners are requested to mention their pension pay order number in all the copies of the documents submitted to the Treasuries.

B) Pensioners residing in foreign countries

Pensioners residing in foreign countries can produce their life certificate after getting it attested by the officials of the Indian embassy and send the same to concerned Treasuries / Pension Pay Office, Chennai. Further, pensioners who have not submitted their PAN card, Aadhaar Number, Core Bank account number can send the copies of the same along with life certificate in the prescribed form to treasuries concerned. Life certificate form can be downloaded from (www.tn.gov.in/Karuvoolam/).

The Pensioners are requested to register their Aadhaar number in the concerned Treasuries for availing the online services. Presently pensioners using Aadhaar Authentication can generate digital life certificate through 'Jeevan Pramaan' Portal. Pensioners / Family Pensioners residing in the foreign countries can also generate their digital life certificate using Aadhaar Authentication through 'Jeevan Pramaan' Portal and send the life certificate digitally.

III. Other Details

The family pensioners (attending in person / unable to attend in person) are requested to produce non- remarriage certificate.

Pensioners are requested to produce their present residential address, mobile number and e-mail id (if available).

Stop-Payment of Pension

Pensioners are informed that pension payment will be stopped from the month of August -2019 onwards for those who do not attend mustering (or) produce life certificate before 30th June, 2019.

V. Pensioners' New Health Insurance Scheme (PNHIS)

Those Pensioners who have not submitted the filled up application under the PNHIS are requested to submit the same without fail.

General Instructions

Those Pensioners and Family Pensioners who were transferred from Public Sector Bank Scheme to Tamil Nadu Government's Pension Pilot Scheme last year are also requested to attend mustering at Pension Pay Office / Treasury Offices concerned from April 1st onwards (or) produce Life Certificate in the prescribed format without fail.

This public notification shall not be applicable to TNEB Pensioners, Railway and Postal Department Pensioners, EPF Pensioners, Central Government Pensioners and Local Body Pensioners.

It is not applicable for the Pensioner / Family Pensioner who already completed the mustering process for the year 2019-2020.
